Biomedical Sciences Academy



- Hands On Focus Industry + Laboratory Research Environment
 - 98% of Seniors pursue post secondary education of that 88% declare a health science degree
- Scientific Research Emphasis Independent Year Long Capstone

 - Class of 2023 offered 7.3 million dollars in scholarships ~ 60 seniors
- 316 students enrolled for 23-24 school year
 - 37 % from outside BNHS feeder pattern





Cosmetology Academy

Unique 2 year program that allows students to stay at their home campus for half the day for their core academics.

TDLR Cosmetology Operator License

- 27 TDLR credit hours / 1000 clock hour equivalency College Level
- Cosmetology license & equipment kit provided by NISD, tuition free.
 - Cosmetology school costs apx \$30,000

Program emphasis:

- 19 Seniors earned their State License in Cosmetology in 2023
- New Cosmetology salon in the NHS renovation









Creative Media Production - CMP Academy

- Graduates have won an Emmy, work at local television stations, and work in college and professional stadiums across the country

Diverse learning experiences including internships, field trips, guest speakers and senior Italy trip each Spring.







STEM Academy

- Small learning community of Core + CTE
 - Core classes Honors, OnRamps (Dual Credit) & Advanced options
 - CTE courses
 - Engineering- Project Lead the Way (PLTW) Curriculum
 - Computer Science- Cybersecurity specialization
- New STEM spaces in the NHS CTE wing 2021 Bond
- Over 100 incoming 9th grade students for Fall 2023 43% from outside NHS feeder pattern
- STEM Events including Women in STEM, EDD Presents, STEM
 Summit and Middle School Robotics Competition







Academy History & What's Next

Academies are turning 15 this year!

2009 - The academy model began with 6 academies! STEM, AMAT (currently CMP), Culinary, Cosmetology, Collegiate & AMP (currently Biomedical Sciences) opened

2015 - Business & Aviation opened with Eaton High School opening

2021 - Collegiate Academy transitioned to Steele Early College HS

2023 - Renovated STEM Academy wing opens at NHS.

Future - Cosmetology will move to NHS and the New Construction Academy with focus on trades & construction science will open at NHS

New high schools will mean new academy opportunities!
