## DES Participates In Read Across America Week

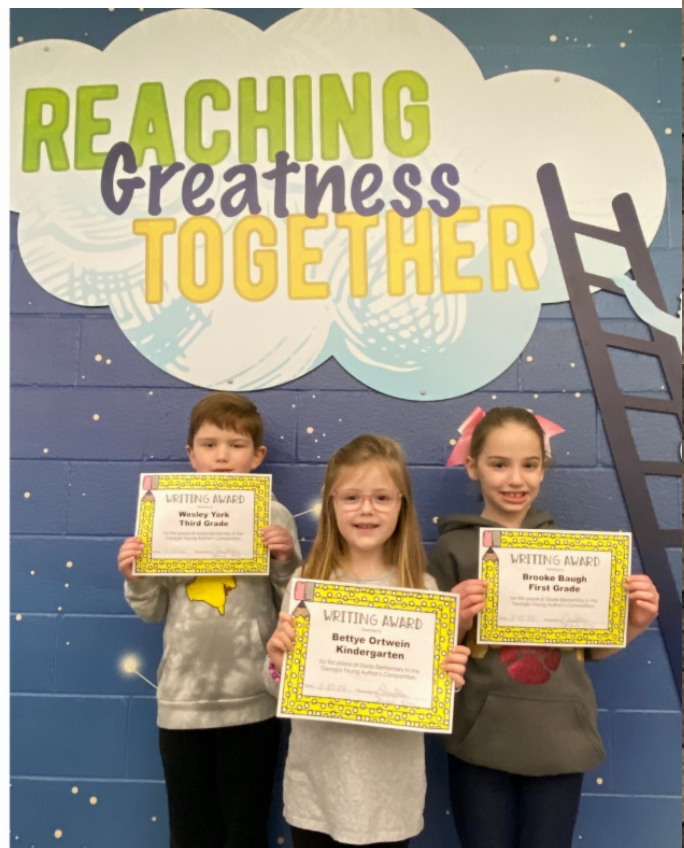

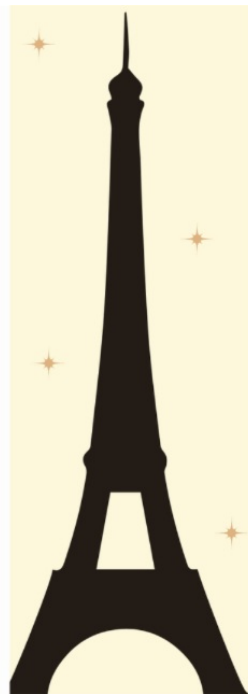
## Davis Students Participate In Fun Run Activity
