Young Georgia Authors Fair District Winners



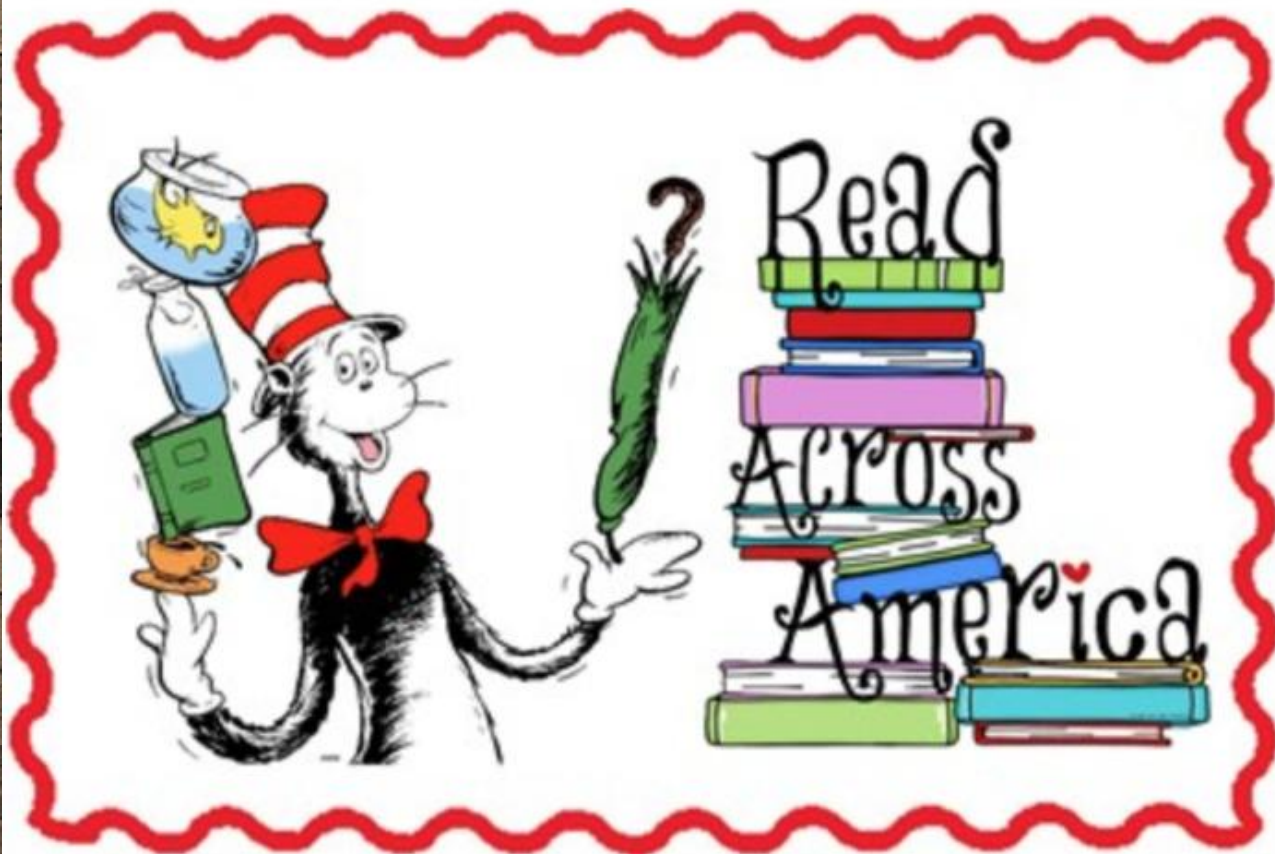
