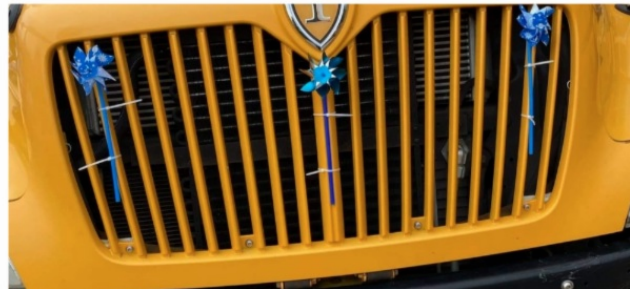


### DCS Goes Blue For Child Abuse Prevention Awareness

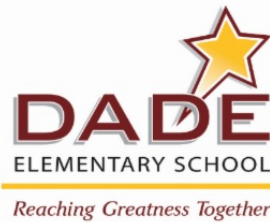

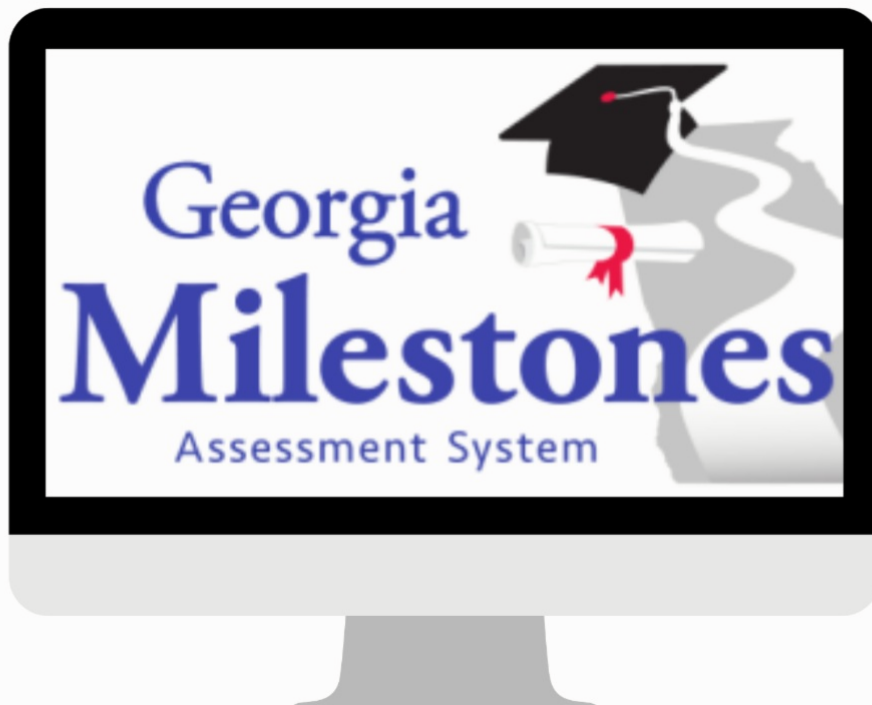
