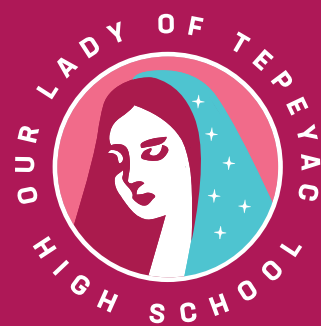

Academics

- We offer college-prep courses in all grade levels
- Honors and AP courses are available in English, Math, Science, History and Spanish
- In STEM, students will learn to program robots, digitally design products, and 3D print
- College Readiness Program all 4 years
- Our small class sizes allow students to be challenged individually

College Readiness.

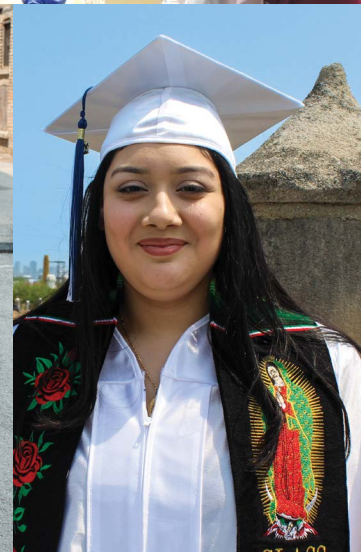
- College Readiness program works with each grade level to set goals, participate in internships, apply to colleges and obtain scholarships and financial aid

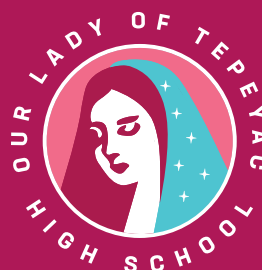
