PSSA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> standards-based, criterion-referenced assessment which provides students, parents, educators and citizens with an understanding of student and school performance related to the attainment of proficiency of the academic standards 	3 days (ELA) 2 days (Math) 2 days (Science) 3 hours per day
SS midterm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> will be given in 7th grade to meet the requirements of the Civics test for PDE 	one class period
Keystone (Algebra 1)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> if a student completes a course aligned to a Keystone Exam during the middle school years, the proficiency outcome is used to determine eligibility for a high school diploma 	60-90 minutes per module
Algebra I final	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> this is a high school course that students will receive credit for if they receive a passing grade follows the high school assessment expectations with a final exam 	one class period
District Common Assessments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> curriculum based to provide classroom, grade level/building, and district data for each grade identify areas of strength and opportunities for growth within the curriculum 	one class period per subject
