<b>Kindergarten Readiness Test (KRT)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• baseline data on individual student readiness</li> <li>• provide school with data to create balanced classrooms</li> </ul>	15 minutes per child
<b>Acadience (ELA)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• provides reliable and valid universal screening to find students who may be at risk for reading difficulties                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ confirm Tier 1 in meeting needs of student</li> <li>◦ identify Tier 2 &amp; Tier 3 student needs</li> </ul> </li> <li>• it directly measures foundational early literacy skills</li> </ul>	10 minutes per child
<b>NWEA MAP</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• provides standards based achievement information on what a student knows and informs what they are ready to learn next</li> <li>• shows common areas of need, identify students who may need intervention, determine what instructional strategies are generating the most growth</li> </ul>	75 minutes (ELA) 75 minutes (Math)
<b>PSSA</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• standards-based, criterion-referenced assessment which provides students, parents, educators and citizens with an understanding of student and school performance related to the attainment of proficiency of the academic standards</li> </ul>	3 days (ELA) 2 days (Math) 2 days (Science) 3 hours per day
<b>District Common Assessments</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• curriculum based to provide classroom, grade level/building, and district data for each grade</li> <li>• identify areas of strength and opportunities for growth within the curriculum</li> </ul>	60 min per subject (ELA & Math)
