REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Returning Students

Online registration for returning students will begin on Monday, August 1, 2022, and continue through Friday, August 12, 2022. All returning students need to re-register for the coming school year.

Parents and guardians will sign in to <https://hscs.powerschool.com/public> using their parent account and click on the Returning Student Enrollment link found in the Navigation menu. Please review the data for accuracy and make the necessary changes. Anyone who has moved and remains in our district is required to meet with the registrar for residency verification.

New Students

Online registration for new students will begin on Monday, August 1, 2022, and continue through Friday, August 12, 2022. Before enrolling your student in our district, residency must be verified. Parents and guardians are required to meet with our registrar and have residency verified. An online registration link will be provided to register your student(s).

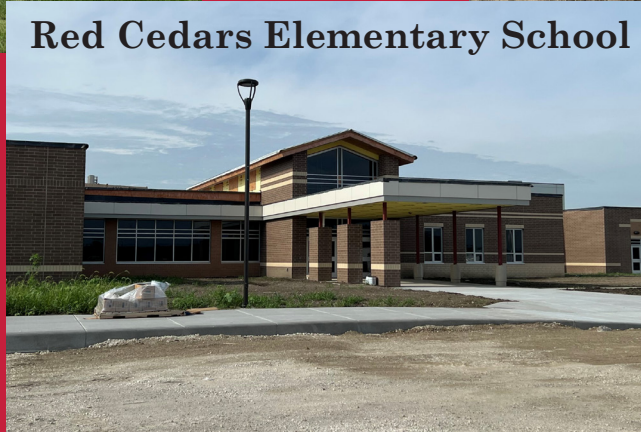

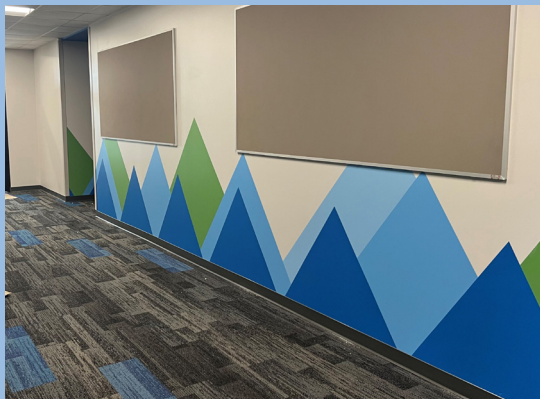
On May 5, 2020, the community voted YES to the referendum which provided the district the opportunity to improve all of the Hanover Community School Corporation campuses, as well as the ability to construct a new 3-5 upper elementary building. This will help the district as we continue to grow at a very fast pace.

Construction began during the summer of 2021. These improvements include: additions and renovations to Hanover Central Middle School and Hanover Central High School, the building of a new community athletic building, the construction of Red Cedars Elementary School, a transportation building, and a new resource center.

Additions to Hanover Central High School include the addition of our new preschool, the Hanover Learning Academy. This is set to open in the fall of 2022. The new resource center will include a bus garage, maintenance and custodial services, technology services, food services, and the administration offices.

Dear Parents and Guardians,

The school meals program is funded by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA). Since the start of COVID-19, school corporations across the country have been operating with the use of a federal waiver that allowed them to feed every child for free through the end of this school year. The use of this waiver will NOT be available this upcoming school year. School corporations will return to the traditional eligibility requirements for free, reduced and paid meals. This means that for school year 2022-2023, our school corporation will process free and reduced-price meal benefit applications.

Meal benefit applications will be available July 1st. You do NOT need to complete an application if:

- You receive notification that your child(ren) are directly certified for the school year 22-23.
- You know your household does not qualify for meal benefits. (Please have money in your child's account on the first day of school.)

Applications received prior to July 1 will not be effective for the 2022-2023 school year. Online applications will be available Aug 1, 2022 at www.mymealtime.com.

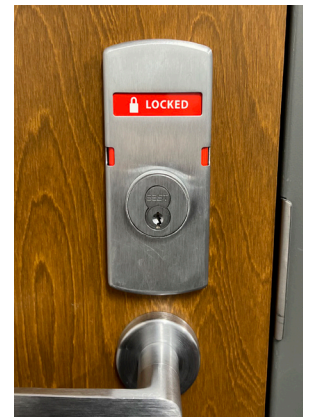
Safety in the classroom

After going through the COVID-19 pandemic, the nation has returned to everyday in-person learning. Like all school districts, student and staff safety is our #1 priority. To ensure that we are prepared for any circumstance, we use a Standard Response Protocol (SRP), which is used by the majority of districts in Lake County.

From the “I Love U Guys” Foundation, “The SRP is based on the response to any given scenario. By standardizing the vocabulary, all stakeholders can understand the response and status of the event. The protocol also allows for a predictable series of responses as an event unfolds.” This organization has given countless schools resources to unify communication between staff, students, first responders, parents, and the community.

Multiple times a school year, in all of our buildings, we conduct lockdown drills, fire drills, tornado drills, and other drills to prepare students and staff for unforeseen circumstances. Students are taught what to do in the event of an emergency at the beginning of the school year.

New locks are being installed on the classroom doors that indicate if the door is locked or unlocked. In 2021, our school corporation received a grant to update the cameras in all of our buildings, to have enhanced state-of-the-art security features. CrisisGo is an application that is used by teachers, staff, administrators, and local law enforcement. It includes alerts, rosters, notice groups, and checklists. Our head of security, Michael O'Donnell, has CrisisGo notify our dispatch center and gives them real-time information about the situation, and we can communicate with them through this program.



Both our middle school and high school have full-time School Resource Officers (SRO), who are constantly watching cameras, monitoring the hallways, and observing students and staff during the school day. When Red Cedars opens in the fall, we hope to have a full time SRO available. Both of our elementary schools have part-time officers that rotate throughout the schools to monitor students and the surroundings. All of our officers have positive interactions with the kids including high fives in the halls, basketball games at recess, participating in school activities, and having conversations in the lunchroom.


