Winterim:

During the first two weeks of January, students engage in on-campus and off-campus experiential learning activities. 11th and 12th graders secure internships as their Winterim experience.

Specialty Diplomas

Scholars—Highlighting intellectual curiosity, this diploma is earned by taking at least 3 AP courses and an additional foreign language credit.

STEM— Students focusing their course choices in the Life Science, Engineering, Computer Science, and Architectural fields will earn a STEM diploma.

Artisan—Students pursuing additional rigorous courses in Language, Performing, and Fine Arts will earn an Artisan diploma.

Missions:

Our mission initiatives allow students to come in contact with a world that is unique from their own, introduce opportunities for them to love big, beyond comforts, and to become open handed to God-inspiring Christian Leadership.

Service:

Each student is required to earn 10 school-based community service hours and 10 hours from within the community at large. By graduation, students have earned 80 community service hours or more through a combination of missions, Days of Service, club-affiliated hours, and personal service desires.
