About Shelton

The June Shelton School was founded on April 2, 1976, by June Shelton and Lawrence and Suzanne Beeman at the request of and with the help of a group of parents of language-learning different students.

Shelton School is a private, state-chartered, nonprofit, nondenominational day school for children with specific language-learning differences. Shelton is the largest school worldwide serving intelligent students who have a learning difference.

Learning differences include Dyslexia, Dysgraphia, Math Disorder, Written Language Disorder, Attention Deficit/ Hyperactivity Disorder and Speech and Oral Language Disorders.

Approximately 1100 students attend Shelton, grades Pre-K through 12th. 363 students in the Upper School, with 78 in the class of 2024.

Ranking and GPA

Shelton only reports class rank for seniors in the top 10% of their class. GPA is cumulative, calculated on a 100-point weighted scale. The passing mark is 70%. Students earn five quality points in Honors and/or Dual Credit courses. Quality points are added to semester grades for GPA calculations but are not included in raw semester grades shown on transcripts. In addition, students earn five fewer points for Modified courses. Advanced Placement courses are not offered at Shelton School.

Graduation Requirements

The school day consists of 8 periods, approximately 45 minutes long. Students are expected to graduate on the recommended plan. Requirements are specified by the Texas Education Agency. This 26-credit program requires: 4 credits English 4 credits Science 4 credits Mathematics 4 credits Social Studies 2 credits Language other than English 1 credit P.E. or P.E. equivalent .5 credit Speech 5.5 credits (which must include 1.5 credits in Ethics, Sociology, and Psychology), 1 credit in Technology, Computer Applications, Web Design, Coding and Robotics, Creative Digital Media, Advanced Photography, Yearbook, Film III or Broadcast Journalism) and .5

Students who are unable to meet the requirements of the recommended plan will graduate on the minimum plan.
