APPEL PROGRAM

What is the APPEL Program?

The Davis APPEL Program is an alternative route to licensure for teachers. It offers candidates the chance to earn their Professional Educator License while working as a classroom teacher.

Who is eligible for APPEL?

The Davis APPEL Program is designed for teachers of record in our district. Paraprofessionals, prep teachers, and substitutes do not qualify for the program at this time.

What if I'm not a current teacher?

You can view our current openings and apply for a teaching position on DSD Jobs. You do not need to hold a teaching license to apply.

How much does it cost?

The Davis APPEL Program is designed to offer a low-cost route to licensure for our teachers. Many of the program requirements and trainings are provided in-house at no cost to the teacher. However, initial Praxis exams, transcript requests, and certain content endorsements may require fees.

How long does it take to complete?

Program length is determined by individual needs, but the program is designed to be completed in 3 years.

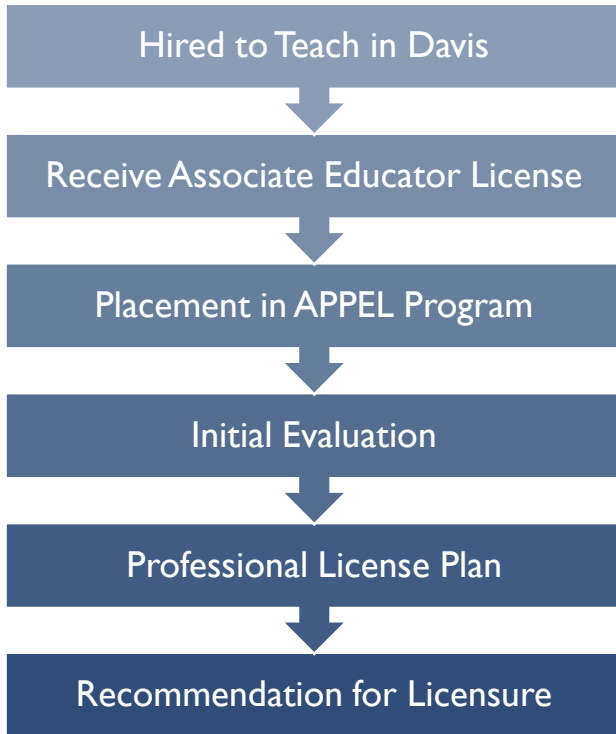

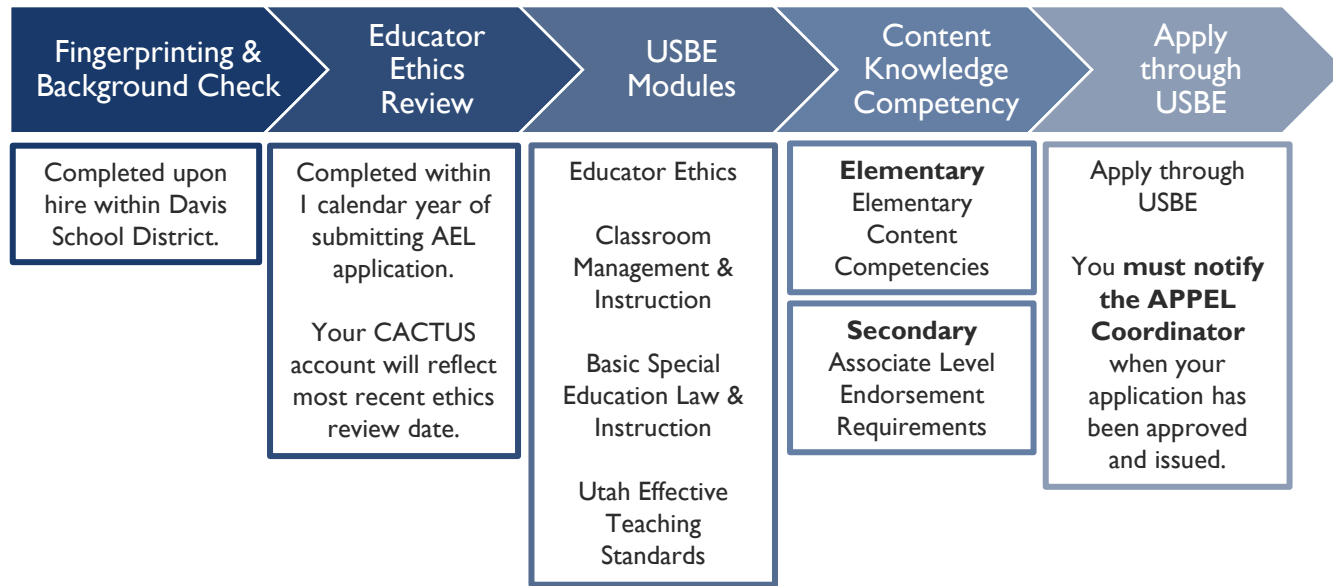
Alternative Pathway to Professional Educator License
