2-Step Sequential Process



1 School Reconfiguration

Reconfigure TK-8 schools (no high schools) beginning school year 2024-25 across the District, such as combining schools and/or changing grade levels at schools:

- Equitable programs across the district
- Access to more resources for students and teachers
- Greater opportunities for all students
- Students, teachers, classified staff, and families benefit

2 Asset Management

Begins after the Board decision regarding school reconfiguration. Identifies how to repurpose property, materials, transportation, and human resources.

- None of the properties are proposed to be sold
- No layoffs due to reconfiguration
- Community will be part of the process



Goals

- Increase student access to co-curricular programs and activities
- Lessen the burden on teachers and classified staff
- Reduce the number of grade-level combination classes

Parameters

- Minimize
 - number of students impacted
 - mileage students will have to travel
 - number of sites impacted
- Be equitable
- Project enrollment with a demographer
- Use facility master plan for site facility conditions

- Facilitated to gather input regarding committee discussions

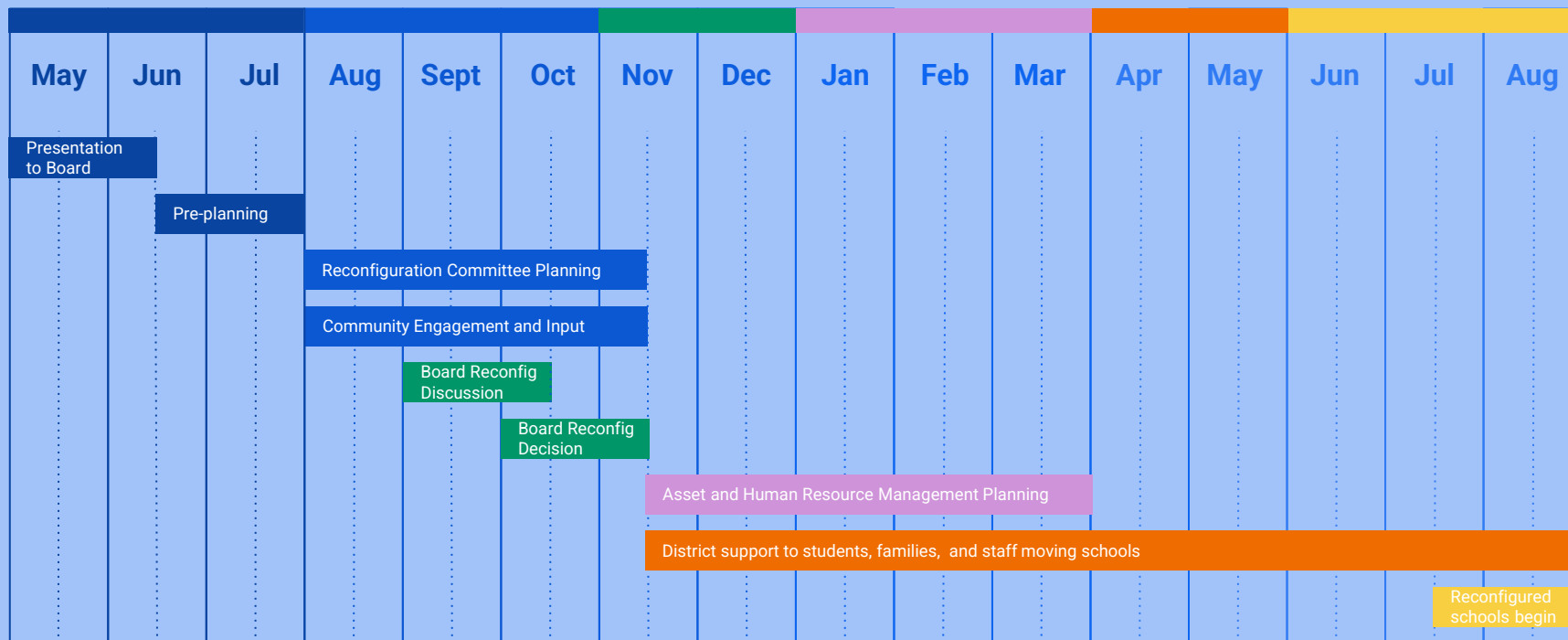
School consolidation recommendations will be discussed in public during at least 2 meetings of the Board of Education
