Arrival and Dismissal

- Arrival- School begins promptly at 8:30am. Students coming to school for breakfast should arrive at 8:00am and line up at the main entrance on Lawrence Street, <u>supervision for breakfast does not begin until 8:00am</u>. All other students should arrive at school no earlier than 8:15am and report to the blacktop area at the rear of the building and get into the appropriate grade-level line. <u>Students should not be coming through the main entrance unless they are coming to school for breakfast</u>. Teaching Assistants will be outside to supervise the line up procedures for all grades beginning at 8:15am.
- ♦ Dismissal- Students are dismissed at 2:45pm and are released through the back doors of the building. Kindergarten students are dismissed from the doors by the nurse's office. Grades 1-3 exit from the rear of the main building. Students in grades 4-6 will exit the doors leading to the playground. If you are late and we cannot reach you or one of your emergency contacts, we will contact the Glens Falls City Police in order to ensure the safety of your child. It is very important that we always have up-to-date information for you and those that you designate as emergency contacts.

Important Information

- First day of school- On the first day of school we will send home a packet of information and forms to be completed with each student. Please review this information and return the completed forms to the school as soon as possible.
- Custody Papers— Please make sure that we have a copy of the most up to date custody document that you have (if applicable). We cannot enforce the restrictions in these documents unless we have a current copy. Please be certain that we treat these documents and the restrictions that they outline as strictly confidential.
- School visitors will be limited, please send your child to school prepared each day.

School Attendance Policy

- ♦ School begins promptly at 8:30am.
- Parent (s) should notify the school nurse prior to 8:30am at 518-792-3231, press option 2 for the nurse's office or lpearl@abewing.org if their child will be absent or tardy.
- A child returning to school after an absence must bring in a written excuse. The excuse must include the child's full name, the reason for the absence, the date (s) absent, a parent or guardian's signature and provider documentation if required.
- If a child is tardy the parent/ guardian must sign them in at the main office. Children are not allowed to come to school late without a parent or guardian.
- If a child must leave during the day, the parent or guardian should send a dated note in with the child advising that he/she will be leaving, what time, the reason why and whether or not he/ she will return to school that day and a phone number the parent can be reached at. All parents or guardians should come to the main office to pick up their child. Students will not be dismissed to walk home during the school day.
