
We have several important events to highlight in the month of August. Our Freshman/New Student Orientation is planned for **Thursday August 31st from 1:00-3:00 p.m.** This event is for all freshmen and their parents/guardians as well as any student who is new to Manchester Valley. That same evening, we will be holding our **Back to School Night from 4:00 – 6:00 p.m.** This event will be an open-house format and is targeted towards all students and their parents/guardians. You will be provided with a chance to walk through your student's first quarter schedule and meet all of his or her teachers. This is a wonderful way to put a name with a face and get a chance to hear what your children need to do to be successful in each of their classes. We will also have an optional information session in the Auditorium for families with the Administrative Team at 5:00pm.

This year, Manchester Valley's academic focus will be Supporting Claims with Evidence, continuing our focus on Literacy across all content areas, preparing students for success on state assessments as well as meeting college and career readiness standards. Extra-curricular activities have begun, with Marching Band and Fall Sports practices already underway. We have two great school community events planned in September to kick off our school year. On Friday, September 22nd we will hold our annual Maverick Stampede, sponsored by the Manchester Valley Athletic Boosters. Start time is 4:00 pm. This event precedes our first home Football game during the school year, which begins at 6:30 pm. Also, our second annual Programs and Pathways night will be held on Thursday, November 9th, from 4:00 – 7:00 pm. This is an opportunity for students and families to get started on the scheduling process for next year and learn about the various courses and programs offered at Manchester Valley from our different content areas. We will also have representatives from local colleges, trade schools, the Career and Technology Center, Business Employment Resource Center and Military Recruiters, among others. Please come out and join us!

Just another quick reminder, the school day starts **at 7:30 am and ends at 2:20 pm**. We expect all students to arrive to their first mod classes on time. Doors will open at 7:00 am, and a bell will dismiss students to move from the main hallway toward their mod 1 class at 7:05 am. After school activities will be able to start at 2:45 pm. Changes to Address, Phone Number or Email:

Please notify us **immediately** when there is a change in your contact information. This is the only way we have to get in touch with Parents/Guardians in the event of an emergency or if an illness should occur with your student.

Please know that if the student's address changes during the course of the school year, we must receive documentation for the student's permanent record. All address changes must be documented by an appropriate proof of residence as mandated by state guidelines.

Acceptable documents for proof of residence include:

- A signed contract on a home in which you are currently residing;
- A signed rental/lease agreement on a home/apartment in which you are residing;
- Recent bill for a service delivered to the residence (i.e., BGE, land-line phone, cable, oil, water)*;
- Recent mortgage statement/bill noting "primary residence";
- Deed (must show house number, street name and name of parent/legal guardian)
- A current settlement document;
- A current tax document indicating "primary residence";
- A Resident Verification Statement accompanied by an acceptable proof of residence for the owner/renter of the property.

***Date on the DOCUMENT must be NO MORE then 60 days from time of notification.**



Once documentation is received, the student's records will be updated. If you need further clarification, please contact the MVHS Registrar, Rhonda Lyman at 410-386-1674.

Reporting Absences:

Every absence must be verified by a student's parent/legal guardian. We will accept any one of the following from the parent or legal guardian to notify us of an absence:

- An email to MVHAttendance@carrollk12.org
- A telephone call to **410-386-4433 by 9am** on the day of absence
- A faxed note to 410-386-1561
- A written note upon the student's return to school.



We will attempt to contact parents through school messenger, if we have not received any communication by the specified time each day. **Parents are required to notify the school within 2 days following any absence**, via phone, fax, email, or note, otherwise the absence will be coded as **unlawful and unexcused**.

**Please note students are not permitted to report their own absence.*

Early Dismissal/Late Arrival Procedures:

- Class hours are 7:30am - 2:20pm. The first bell rings at 7:05am, allowing students to go to their lockers and classrooms. A five minute warning bell rings at 7:25am. The final bell rings at 7:30am when students should be in their classroom ready to begin. Students not in their 1st mod classrooms by the 7:30am bell are considered late to school and will result in a tardy referral.
- Students that arrive late to school due to appointments or other reasons, will need to check in at the Main Office. ***Medical/Dental doctor notes must be received for the student to be eligible to participate in extra curriculars that day.**
- Students should bring a parent/guardian note to the cafeteria before school to receive an early dismissal pass to leave class at the designated time. At the designated dismissal time the student must sign out at the main office and leave the building when the parent/guardian arrives, or if they drive themselves to school they may leave at this time.
- We understand that occasionally it is not possible to know of an appointment in advance. In such situations, please call the MVHS Attendance office at **410-386-1673** once you are aware of a required early dismissal, so we can locate the student to dismiss them to you.

- A parent must drop off the medication to the school nurse during school hours

- In addition, August 31st is back to school night, medications may be dropped off between 4:00pm — 6:00pm
- Students cannot self-carry medication unless the prescribing physician has signed off on the medication order form (ex. Epi Pens and Inhalers)

Permission to Photograph, Videotape or Audiotape

If you do not wish to have your child's name or likeness published by the media, you should address your concerns directly to the school involved so that the media is so advised. Please be advised that the school system has no control over the media when they are covering activities such as sporting events and musical programs that are open to the public.

The Maryland Motor Vehicle Administration (MVA) requires all applicants under the age of 16 to have their school attendance verified before receiving their Learner's Permit.

Please refer to the MVA website www.marylandmva.com to download the Maryland MVA Learner's Permit School Attendance Certification Form (DL-300). Students may also pick up the form from the Main Office. Please complete Section A of the form and submit it to the school office for verification. We will compile the attendance information and complete the form within 24 hours. The form must remain in the sealed envelope to be taken to the MVA.

Do you OWE?

Students owing obligations WILL NOT be issued any school materials, including textbooks, extracurricular equipment (including athletic uniforms), parking permits or be permitted to purchase tickets to extra curricular activities until their obligation has been resolved. If you know that your child has an outstanding obligation, please encourage him or her to either return the materials or pay any fees that are owed promptly. Students can see Ms. Mary Geiman in the Main Office to settle obligations.

Payments to MVHS

We strongly encourage parents to pay by check or through **MySchoolBucks.com** when sending money to school. This will alleviate the possibility of the student losing cash or having it stolen, and provides a paper trail. Please be aware that any check written to MVHS that is returned is subject to a returned check fee.

Meal Account and PIN Information

- Every student who goes through our cafeteria line will use a unique Personal Identification Number (PIN) to access his or her account. Parents have the option to add any denomination to the account for the purchase of meals and snack items. It is a convenient way to ensure that money is not lost or forgotten during the hectic morning rush.
- What is the PIN? Each student has been issued a unique, five-digit PIN. Parents can find their child's PIN in the CCPS Home Access Center (HAC). Once you sign on, the Cafeteria PIN will be located in the emergency section. Please help your child remember their number. It makes the line move faster and ensures that everyone has plenty of time to enjoy their meal. If they do happen to forget the number, the cashier will be able to find it for them.
- How do I put money on the account?
 - Visit www.myschoolbucks.com and set up a free account that allows you to add any value to the cafeteria account with a credit card. (There is a small service provider fee for each transaction.)
 - You can still send in cash or a check to your school's cafeteria. The cafeteria manager will add it to the account. Checks made payable to your child's school.
 - The money added to the account can be used to purchase meals AND snack items.
- Can I monitor what my child is purchasing? Visit www.myschoolbucks.com and set up a FREE account. Once you complete the simple registration process, you can set up low balance alerts and monitor purchases made in the cafeteria.
- What happens to my account at the end of the school year? Money that remains on your child's account will carry over from year to year. The account will also automatically transfer to any Carroll County Public School.






