Google Docs	<a href="https://docs.google.com">docs.google.com</a>	<p>Word processing tool to allow students to create and edit text and paragraphs. Students can collaborate on the same document and teachers can easily provide feedback while students are working.</p>	
Google Sheets	<a href="https://sheets.google.com">sheets.google.com</a>	<p>Spreadsheet tool for analyzing, visualizing and charting data. Similar to the other G:Suite tools, students can easily share and collaborate in real-time.</p>
