Get Creative—Magic

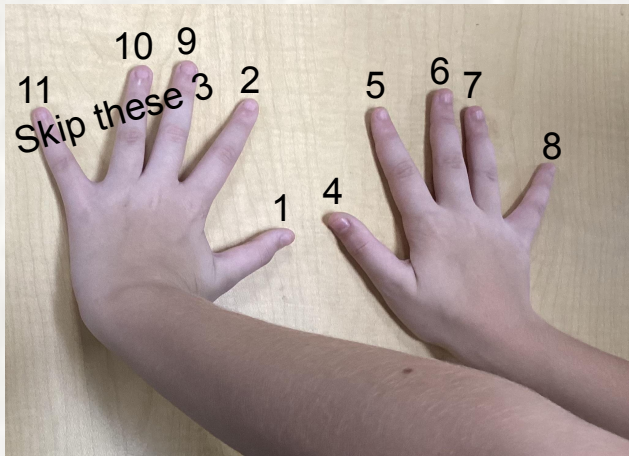


One of our newspaper team members had the idea to get creative! We are looking to spotlight students who have a passion for crafts, magic, video gaming tips or recommendations, art projects, graphic design, music or more. Emma Weeks wanted to share a magic trick to kick off this edition.



Magic: Wait...How Many Fingers Do I Have Again..?

How to do it: Get a friend or family member, and ask them to lay their hands flat on the table. Begin counting their fingers. Count their thumb: one, count their pointer finger: two. Group their middle, ring, and pinky fingers: skip these three, begin counting the fingers on their other hand. Their thumb: four, and so on. Once you're done counting their other hand, go back and count the three you skipped. "Nine, ten, eleven!" The trick is, when you say "skip these three," you continue counting four, five, six and so on on their other hand.
