WHAT IS DUAL CREDIT?

- A high school student enrolled in a dual credit course simultaneously earns college and high school credit. Course grades will appear on both college and high school transcripts.
- Courses offered for dual credit include the same content and rigor as courses taught to other college students, utilizing the same instructors, curriculum and policies.
- Dual credit courses may be taught at the high school campus or online.
- Dual Credit courses must be taught by college credentialed instructors according to criteria established by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS).
- Tuition and fees apply. WC offers a Dual Enrollment Grant based on financial need. This grant covers up to 6 credit hours of tuition per fall and spring semester. Visit the dual credit website for more details.
