- COMPLETE PLACEMENT TESTING.**
- ENROLL IN CLASSES WITH WEATHERFORD COLLEGE.**
- MAKE PAYMENTS OR SET UP PAYMENT PLANS.**
  - **DUAL CREDIT ONLY:** If you would like to be considered for a need-based Dual Enrollment Grant (DEG), please fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA). Eligible students may be awarded up to 6 hours of in-district tuition each fall and spring semester to cover tuition costs for dual credit classes. The grant does not cover lab fees or textbooks.
- PURCHASE OR RENT TEXTBOOKS.**
- REQUEST ACCOMMODATIONS.**

Early enrollment students must maintain a minimum grade of a “C” or higher in each course in order to maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) and /or to remain currently enrolled. Not maintaining SAP may impact financial aid eligibility after high school graduation.
