- Stop what you are doing
- Look around you
- Listen to and follow instructions.

When we need to stay safe, remember



L = LOCKDOWN

• I = INFORM

• C= COUNTER

• E= EVACUATE



In a Lockdown

Inside, with your class

an adult will tell you what to do

Alone

 if you are alone, you can decide what to do all by yourself.



Modified Lockdown

• MODIFIED LOCKDOWN means that we lock the outside doors, but we can move around inside of our school.

A = ALERT

- ALERT happens when there is an announcement that someone is nearby, and we need to stay safe.
- If we hear an announcement in our school we always STOP, LOOK, and LISTEN.
- Be very, very quiet. Silent.





L = LOCKDOWN

LOCKDOWN means that we:

- Lock the outside doors and the classroom doors.
- STAY quiet and out of sight.
- Don't try to hide in a closet.
- MOVE apart and be ready to move around.

= INFORM

• INFORM means that we tell others what we know.



C= COUNTER

COUNTER means that if there is someone we need to stay safe from. We do our best to make things hard for that person.

We can

- block the door.
- Pick up and throw objects at the person.
- Yell and scream at the person.



E= EVACUATE

- EVACUATE means leave the building and run away.
- When you run:
 - Run in a zigzag line.
 - Find a safe place to hide.
