

- 1. Select one of the I Spy Pages and place it in front of you and the child.
- 2. Make sure the child is aware of the correct names of the objects and/or shapes on the page. you are satisfied the child knows the names of the objects move on to the next step. emphasize the beginning sound when you point to it. (i.e. "This is a frog - fff - frog." Once time and ask the child what it is called. - 3. Look at the page and silently select an object.
