Senior Tables

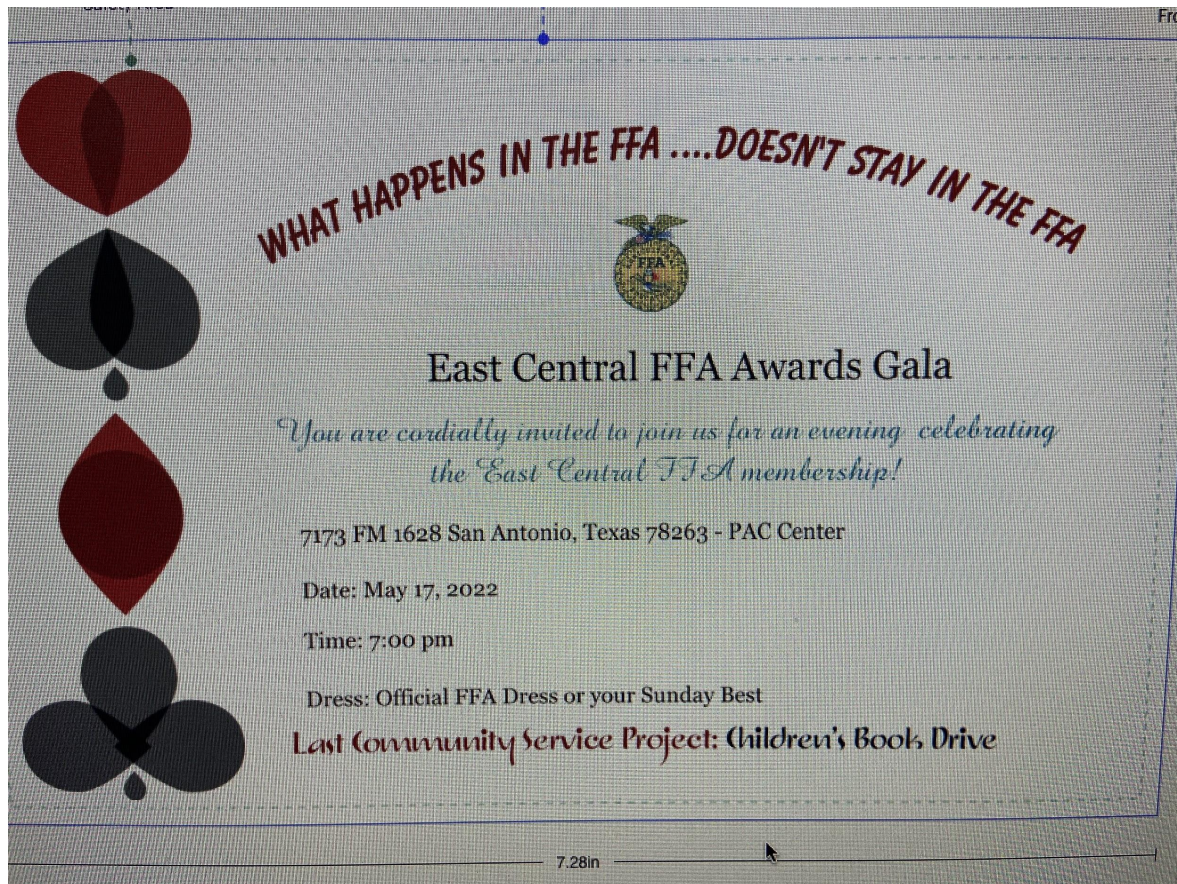
