Eligibility

Students who show courage when dealing with epilepsy and seizures, a strong commitment to their education, and perseverance in eliminating the obstacles epilepsy and seizures may present are welcome to apply for the *Erika Foundation Educational Scholarship*. This program is made possible by a partnership between the Epilepsy Foundation Central & South Texas and the [Erika Epilepsy Awareness Memorial Foundation](#). To be eligible for this scholarship, applicant must:

- Have a diagnosis of epilepsy/seizure disorder
- Provide proof of acceptance to a post-secondary academic or vocational program
- Be a High School Senior or currently enrolled at a trade school, college, or university and be in good standing
- Be a legal resident of Central and South Texas

Online application includes upload sections to submit supporting documents. Supporting documents are required for completion of the application. Application will allow you to save your work and return at a later date to complete. Applications are due on April 17, 2019.

Supporting Documents

The following supporting documents are required to submit the application. Documents are to be uploaded with the application.

Transcript

Physician's Statement - Must have epilepsy, be under a physician's care, and currently undergoing treatment and/or taking anticonvulsant medications.

One Letter of Reference - Suggestions for references letters might be from a teacher, clergy, volunteer experience.

Verification of Acceptance to School - Acceptance letter must be from a college or university.

Additional documents you would like to share with the committee, this is optional and not required.
