AFROTC (Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps) is a program where you can get a college degree and serve your country at the same time. Balancing a normal college lifestyle and military training, we develop quality citizens and leaders.

With over 1000 universities offering this program, you can choose to attend any university and receive the same training!

Military Commitment

Most Air Force Specialty Codes (AFSC): **4 years**

Pilots: **10 years** after two year pilot training

Combat Systems Officers, Remotely Piloted Aircraft Pilots, Air Battle Managers: **6 years** after training

High School Scholarship Eligibility

- ✓ United States citizen
- ✓ Cumulative GPA of **3.0 or higher**
- ✓ Complete the Physical Fitness Assessment
- ✓ Be **17** years old prior to scholarship activation
- ✓ SAT composite of **1240**
- or**
- ✓ ACT composite of **26**
- ✓ Interview with Air Force ROTC

If you are not eligible for a high school scholarship, you can still join Air Force ROTC by enrolling in "Aerospace Studies"

Program Requirements

- Be a United States Citizen
- Be in good academic standing
- Have at least three academic years remaining in a four-year degree program.
- Have a military certified/qualified physical
- Be physically fit; meet AF height and weight standards
- Pass the Air Force Officer Qualification Test (AFOQT)

Academic Standards

- Cadets must complete aerospace studies classes with a grade of **C- or above** and must pass all Leadership Laboratories.
- Cadets on scholarship must maintain a minimum **2.5 CGPA** and be enrolled as a full-time student at the University of Missouri or a crosstown university.
- Cadets not on scholarship must maintain a minimum **2.0 CGPA** and be enrolled as a full-time student at University of Missouri or a crosstown university.

Physical Fitness Standards

- Cadets take a physical fitness test every semester.
- The test is comprised of a waist measurement, pushups, situps, and a 1.5 mile run.

Most ROTC detachments train at least 2x a week.

Scholarships

The majority of scholarships are offered to students in technical fields deemed critical by the Air Force.

Type 1 - Full college tuition, most fees and an annual book allowance of \$900.

Type 2 - Pays college tuition and most fees up to \$18,000 and an annual book allowance of \$900. If student attends institution where tuition exceeds \$18,000, the student pays the difference.

Type 7 - Pays college tuition up to a public school's in-state rate and an annual book allowance of \$900. The University of Missouri offers in-state tuition rates to all contracted and scholarship cadets.

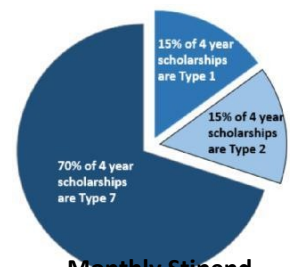
Scholarship Length

- **4-yr** scholarships activate in the fall of your freshman year.
- **3-yr** scholarships activate in the fall of your sophomore year.

Special Programs

Graduate Law: The Air Force offers 1 or 2 year programs for current law students. Upon approval, students are guaranteed a position as a Judge Advocate General after completing Law School.

Accelerated Program: Already started college? AFROTC offers 3 year programs to prior enlisted personnel or students who have some college done.

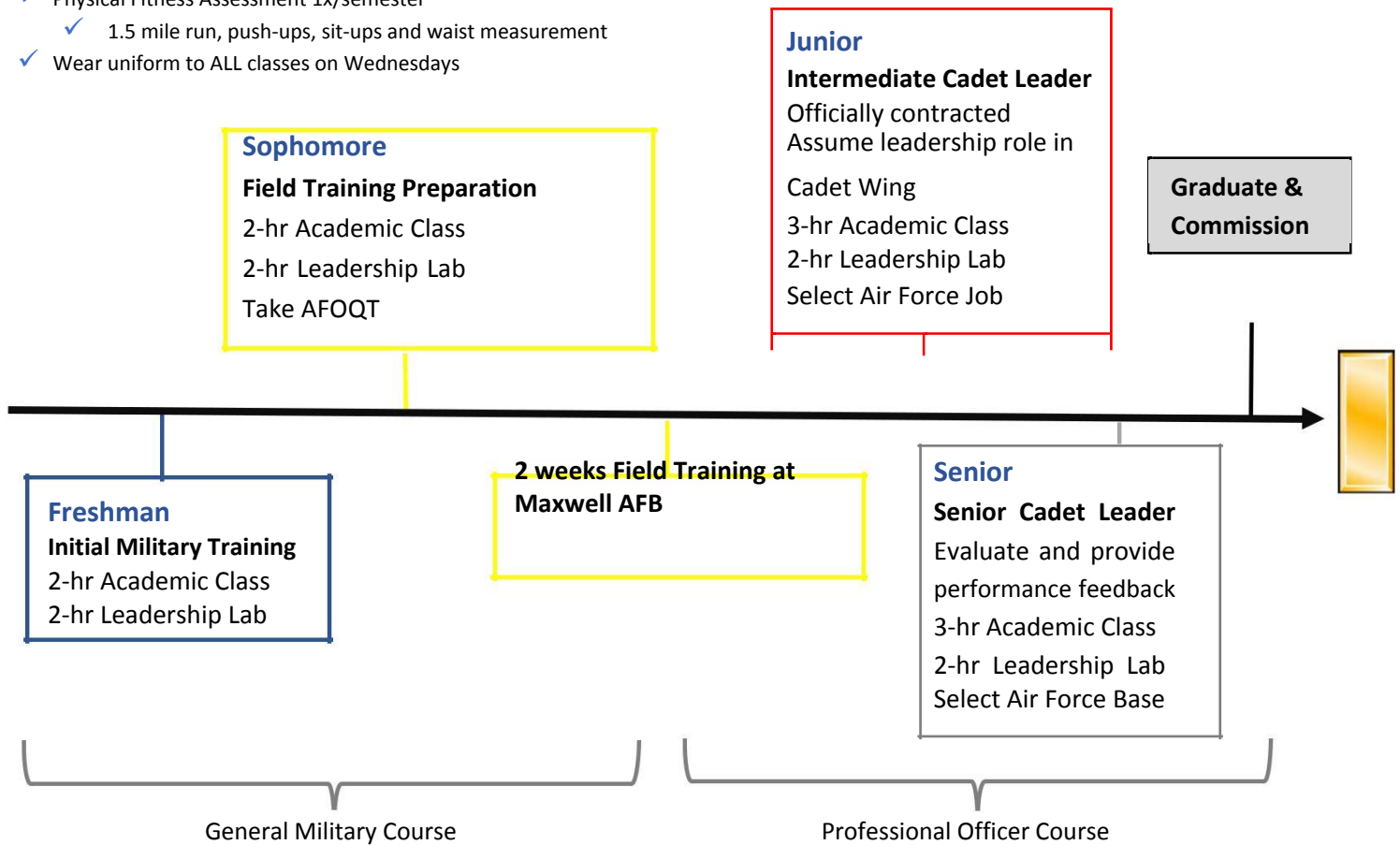

What to Expect as an AFROTC Cadet

- ✓ Two one-hour Physical Fitness Training sessions per week
- ✓ Physical Fitness Assessment 1x/semester
 - ✓ 1.5 mile run, push-ups, sit-ups and waist measurement
- ✓ Wear uniform to ALL classes on Wednesdays
