- Basic fact fluency is an expectation.



Expectations For Basic Fact Memorization

• While in grade 5, students are expected to retrieve from memory all addition facts with addends to 10 and sums to 18.



Resources will be shared to parents in the coming weeks to help practice at home.

- While in grade 5, students are expected to retrieve from memory all subtraction facts with differences to 10, minuends to 18 and subtrahends to 10.
- While in grade 5, students are expected to retrieve from memory all multiplication facts up to the 10's table.
- While in grade 5, students are expected to retrieve from memory all division facts with divisors to 10 and quotients to 10.




Accessing Your Child's Grades


