## COVID-19 STATEMENT

Following our COVID shutdown, Deerfield-Windsor School re-opened for the 2020-2021 academic year with in-person instruction five days a week. However, we still offered a distance learning option in which students could view and participate in our in-person classes via a web platform. However, distance learners were required to complete all summative assessments on campus.

For the 2021-2022 academic year, Deerfield-Windsor required in-person attendance unless students were temporarily quarantined. Quarantined students were then allowed to utilize our digital learning option to remain engaged in class instruction.

In August 2022, Deerfield-Windsor fully resumed pre-COVID operations without a distance learning option.

## GRADING & RANKINGS

Due to our selective admissions processes, highly competitive programs, and the size and makeup of the student body, DWS does not rank its students academically.

In addition, DWS provides additional weight to our most rigorous courses to account for the additional academic challenges they provide.

- ❖ Accelerated (AC) and Advanced (Adv.) courses receive a weight of three points on the semester average and an additional half quality point (0.5) is awarded upon course completion
- ❖ Advanced Placement (AP) courses receive a weight of five points on the semester average and an additional quality point (1.0) is awarded upon course completion

GPA does not include athletic conditioning or any non-academic arts. A minimum of 22 curricular hours and 55 hours of community service are required for graduation.
