Chairman Ed Slattery called the meeting to order at 10:00 AM with the following members present: Edward Slattery, Janet DiTarando, Pamela Faircloth, Bob Audet, and Sheila Dunn. Absent from the meeting: Nancy Sirois and Patty Noblet. Also in attendance were Carole Slattery, Bill Campbell and Maureen Gabriele.

No one attended to speak at Public Forum.

After review the minutes of July 25, 2023 were unanimously approved by a motion made by Bob Audet and seconded by Janet DiTarando.

No report for the Secretary at this meeting.

The Treasurer's Report was presented by Bob Audet. On July 1, 2023 the balance in the account was \$43,275.76 and during the month \$190.35 was added in interest bringing the new total to \$43,466.15. This does not reflect the purchase of the benches recently purchased. A motion was made by Sheila Dunn and seconded by Janet DiTarando to approve the report as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

Janet DiTarando reported on behalf of the Walking Group and the purchase of and placement of the benches. Due to weather issues it has not been possible to have a celebration. It is anticipated that in the coming month we will try again. The bench is located at the trail to trails off of Route 30 across from Arthur Murray's Dance studio. Parking is also available in that parking lot. Ed Slattery requested a motion to approve the report. Bob Audet made a motion and Sheila Dunn seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

Maureen Gabriele, Director shared information about the happenings at the Center: Evening hours have begun for Tuesday and Thursdays until 8:00 PM.
