## St. Martin Parish COVID-19 Guidelines- Approved May 3, 2023

Face Coverings	Face coverings are optional on school campuses.
Symptoms/Fever	<ul> <li>Pre-pandemic school exclusion policies will be followed per district policy JGCC</li> </ul>
Positive COVID  cases Official LA Department of Health/CDC recommendations for K-12 schools and Childcare centers	<ul> <li>All positive cases should be reported to the School Based Health Center for students and Human Resources for staff.</li> <li>Option 1-For positive cases with symptoms:         <ul> <li>Stay home for 5 days-You are most likely infectious during these first 5 day.</li> <li>If symptoms are resolving after 5 days, the student/staff can return to school.</li> <li>If the student/staff continues to have a fever or if symptoms have not improved after 5 days, stay in isolation until fever-free for at least 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Option 2-For positive cases with no symptoms         <ul> <li>Wear a high-quality mask if you must be around others at home and in public.</li> <li>Staff/students positive for COVID-19 and NO symptoms may remain at work and mask for the first 5 days of infection- You are most likely infectious during these first 5 day.</li> <li>Do not go places where you are unable to wear a mask.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

Absences	<ul> <li>An excused absence will be entered when a doctor's excuse is provided confirming a positive COVID case.</li> <li>Home COVID tests will be excused for students if a picture of the positive is provided.</li> <li>The parent's choice to quarantine without a documented positive case will not be an excused absence unless the student has been quarantined by a physician as documented by a doctor's excuse.</li> <li>Those with COVID will be coded •66 – medical quarantine, then U071 – for positive Covid – 19 case</li> </ul>
Individuals exposed to COVID-19	<ul> <li>If a student quarantines after an exposure, the absence will be excused only with a doctor's excuse.</li> <li>The Webpams code is *66</li> <li>Staff who quarantine after an exposure must use their sick days.</li> <li>If any exposed individual tests positive, see directions for positive cases above.</li> </ul>

## **COVID VACCINATION POLICY**
