## WHAT IS NJHS?

Scholarship. Service. Leadership. Character. Citizenship. These are the five areas of excellence demonstrated by NJHS members. Membership into National Junior Honor Society recognizes students for their academic accomplishments, but also challenges them to be actively engaged in other school activities as well as complete community service and to become a more well-rounded young adult.

## WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS OF NJHS?

- \*Induction into NJHS (typically occurs in April of 7<sup>th</sup> grade year)
- \*3.7 (NOT rounded) cumulative GPA or higher
- \*completion of required community service projects (30 total hours with deadlines throughout the year)
- \*demonstrate positive character and citizenship (no office referrals or behavioral concerns)

## WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF NJHS?

Upon completion of middle school requirements, the names of students will be submitted to the high school Beta Club and National Honor Society. Additionally, those who maintain membership will qualify for the trip to Snow Creek in January as well as an end-of-season gathering in May.
