



## JK- GRADE 1 APPLICATION PROCESS

---

- \_\_\_ Submit application for each child with a \$100 non-refundable fee on or before JK/K - December 31, 2023 and Grade 1 - January 15, 2024.\* Once the application is processed, parents can view the admissions checklist in myCCS. Detailed instructions for completing the application can be found at [www.charlottechristian.com/admissions](http://www.charlottechristian.com/admissions).
- \_\_\_ Upload a copy of your child's birth certificate to myCCS.
- \_\_\_ Contact a CAIS psychologist to schedule WPPSI-IV Test (Wechsler Preschool and Primary Scale of Intelligence - Fourth Edition). Request that scores be mailed to Charlotte Christian School (See CAIS booklet for providers.)
- \_\_\_ After November 1, please request the teacher recommendation from your child's current teacher through the checklist in myCCS. The recommendation should be completed before February 1, 2024.\*
- \_\_\_ After an application has been received the admissions office will schedule a 45-minute on-campus playdate. Visits occur November through February. Families will meet with an admissions director and/or lower school administration. This conversation is an opportunity to learn more about Charlotte Christian School and share your goals for the next step in your student's educational journey.
- \_\_\_ File materials (teacher recommendation, results of CAIS testing, and a copy of your student's birth certificate) should be completed by February 1, 2024.\* The progress of your student's application can be viewed through myCCS. Timely receipt of these materials supports an efficient process for both the student and Charlotte Christian School.
- \_\_\_ The progress of your student's application can be viewed through myCCS.
- \_\_\_ Admissions decisions for JK-K and siblings of JK-K applicants will be posted on the decision tab in myCCS on February 23, 2024.\* Admissions decisions for grades 1-12 will be posted on the decisions tab in myCCS on March 28, 2024.

\*All dates represent those observed by Charlotte Area Independent Schools (CAIS) for priority consideration. After these dates, Charlotte Christian School maintains rolling admissions where grade level space permits.
