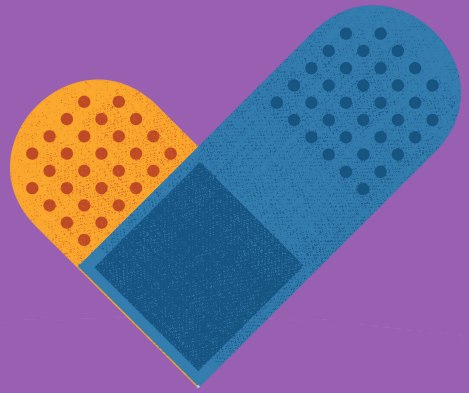


Test positive for COVID?

What to know about COVID treatment

- Treatment can prevent hospitalization and death.
- Treatment needs to be started quickly after starting to feel sick.
- Treatment is safe, effective, widely available, and recommended for most adults and some teens.

Treatment for COVID-19



If you test positive for COVID-19, you might be eligible for treatment to help prevent severe illness. Contact your doctor for more information. Find nearby Test to Treat locations where you can get tested and receive medication at the same place at direc.to/hETW, or scan this QR code.



Frequently Asked Questions

Who is eligible for COVID-19 Treatment?

People may be eligible for treatment if they meet the following criteria:

- At least 12 years old and at least 88 pounds
- Have a positive test result for COVID-19
- Feeling sick with symptoms that started in the past five days
- Not taking any medications which might interact with treatment for COVID-19. If you see a doctor to discuss treatment, take an updated list of your medications with you.
- Risk factors for severe COVID-19 as described by the Centers for Disease Control at direc.to/hETZ, or scan this QR code.



Common risk factors include:

- Over 65 years old
- Compromised immune system
- Diabetes
- Cancer
- Chronic disease of the liver, kidneys, heart, lungs
- Overweight, obesity
- Disabilities

What type of treatment is offered at Test to Treat locations?

For people who aren't in the hospital, the most common form of treatment is a set of pills taken twice a day for five days.

Is there a cost for the treatment?

The medication is free, but there might be a charge to see the doctor or pharmacist at the Test to Treat location. Some insurance plans may cover the cost to see the doctor or pharmacist.
