Covid-19 Positive Student

- Lab confirmed antigen test
- Lab confirmed PCR test

❖ BISD will honor at home test results and/or international test results.

Campus/Dept. Designee (Nurse):

- 1) Consistent with school notification requirements for other communicable diseases, and consistent with legal confidentiality requirements, schools must report to the County/ Local Health Department.
- 2) Follow recommended procedures for cleaning, sanitizing and disinfecting to help prevent harmful germs from spreading among children and staff.

For positive cases Conditions to return:

- at least 5 days have passed since symptoms first appeared.
- at least one day (24 hours) has passed since recovery (resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications);
- the individual has improvement in symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath); and
- Recommended the use of a face mask for 5 additional days after returning to school.
**If you have a fever, continue to stay home until your fever resolves.*

- 1) **Submit data to Human Resources at covid19@bisd.us.**
- 2) **Consistent with school notification requirements for other communicable diseases, and consistent with legal confidentiality requirements, schools must report to the County/ Local Health Department.**
- 3) **Follow recommended procedures for cleaning, sanitizing and disinfecting to help prevent harmful germs from spreading among children and staff.**

For positive cases Conditions to return:
