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## **COVID-19 Flow Chart for Positive STUDENTS**

### **Covid-19 Positive Student**

- Lab confirmed antigen test
- Lab confirmed PCR test

BISD will honor at home test results and/or international test results. **Campus/Dept. Designee (Nurse):** 

- Consistent with school notification requirements for other communicable diseases, and consistent with legal confidentiality requirements, schools must report to the County/ Local Health Department.
- 2) Follow recommended procedures for cleaning, sanitizing and disinfecting to help prevent harmful germs from spreading among children and staff.

### For positive cases Conditions to return:

- at least 5 days have passed since symptoms first appeared.
- at least one day (24 hours) has passed since recovery (resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications);
- the individual has improvement in symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath); and
- Recommended the use of a face mask for 5 additional days after returning to school.
  <u>\*If you have a fever, continue to stay</u> home until your fever resolves.

### **Covid-19 Positive Employees**

- Lab confirmed antigen test
- Lab confirmed PCR test

#### BISD will honor at home test results and/or international test results.

Campus/Dept. Designee administrator:

- 1) Submit data to Human Resources at covid19@bisd.us.
- Consistent with school notification requirements for other communicable diseases, and consistent with legal confidentiality requirements, schools must report to the County/ Local Health Department.
- Follow recommended procedures for cleaning, sanitizing and disinfecting to help prevent harmful germs from spreading among children and staff.

#### For positive cases Conditions to return:

- at least 5 days have passed since symptoms first appeared.
- at least one day (24 hours) has passed since recovery (resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications);
- the individual has improvement in symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath); and
- Recommended the use of a face mask for 5 additional days after returning to school/ work.

\*If you have a fever, continue to stay <u>home until fever resolves.</u>
