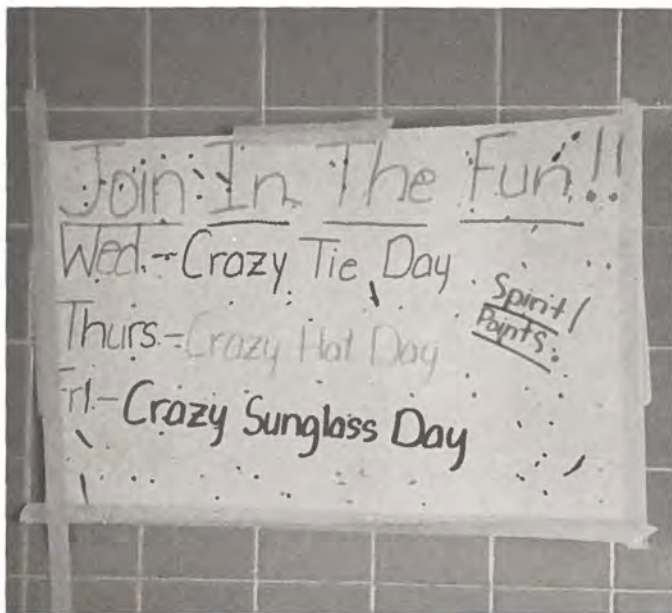

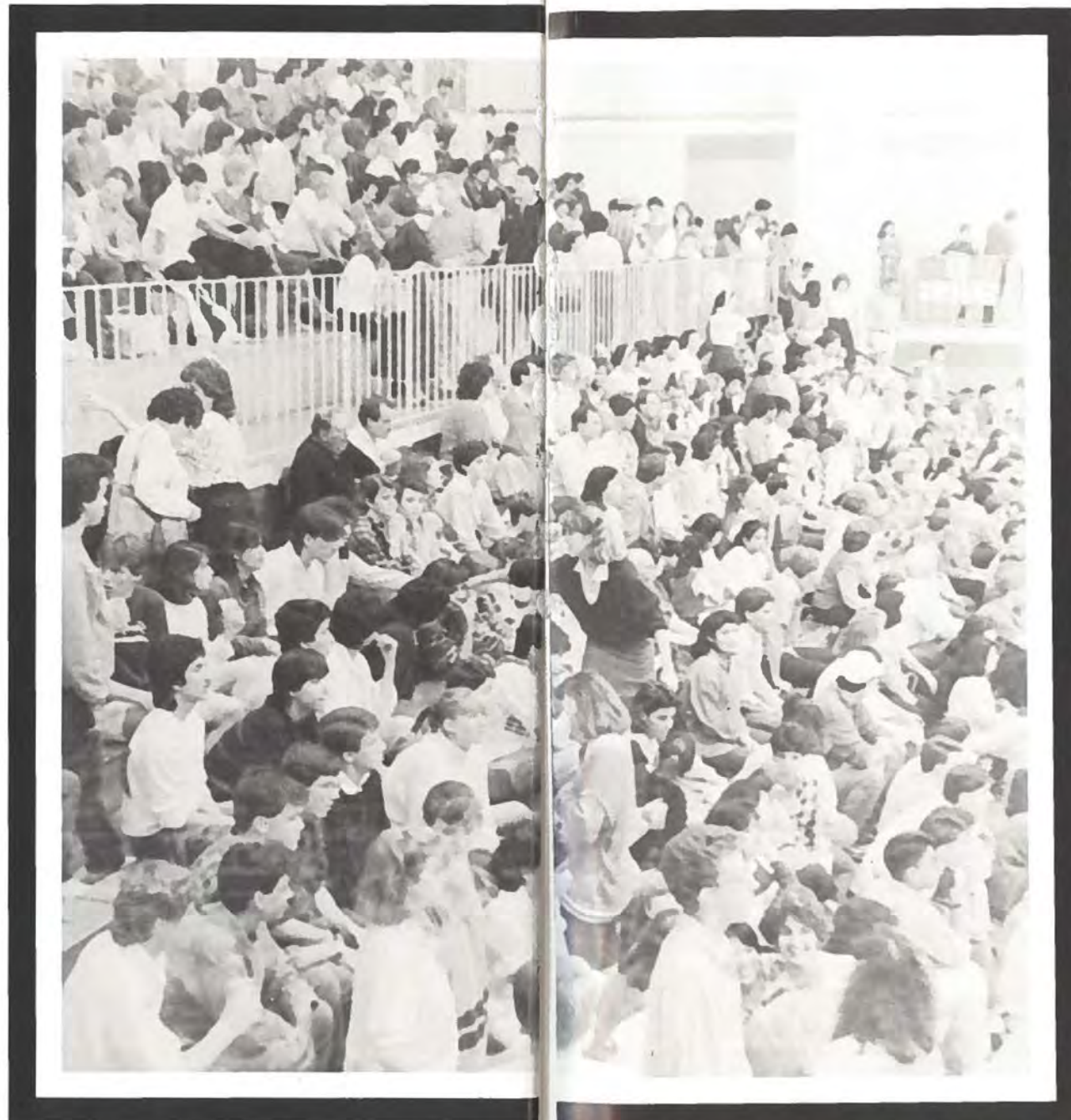

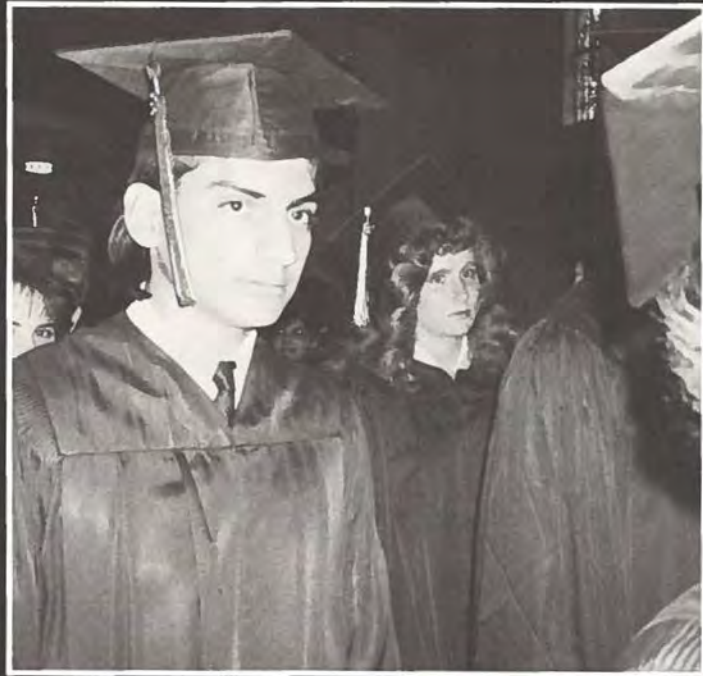

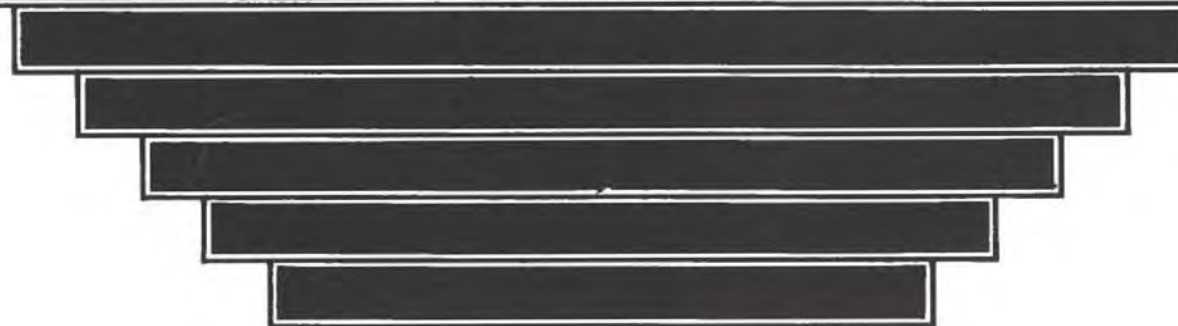

Angels Take Double Honors at State

The Incarnate Word Angels again made sports history by taking both the boys' and girls' 3A basketball titles at the TCIL State Tournament February 13-14.

In 1908 IWA was the first school in the TCIL to win joint championships, and the Angels repeated the feat in 1981. No other school has ever accomplished this.

The boys took the championship in a thrilling overtime game against old rival Houston Marian Christian 64-58. The Angels, led by Jason Williams' 33 points, defeated a team that featured Houston Rockets star Akeem Olujuwon's brothers.

The Angels led by one at the half, and, with 14 seconds left to play in the third quarter, the official realized there were six Marian players on the court. Mackey Smith hit the free throw following the technical.

Darryl Allen, Joe Van Maren, and Mackey Smith each scored eight points in the game.

The Angel Boys made it to the finals with an easy 66-49 win over San Antonio Saint Gerard's.

The girls reached the championship game by defeating the Houston Marian Christian girls 49-29. In the finals, they went against old rival St. Joseph's, who had been defeated twice this year by the Angels.

The girls had the advantage of a 16-0 lead in the first quarter of the final game, and Valerie Valerio had eleven steals. This performance ran her season total to 143, a new school high. She also scored 20 points, which was her career best.

Jenny Sehy with 11 points also stood out, and she made 13 rebounds. Her 11 points gave her 290 points for the season. She topped the previous record of 287 that was set by Coach Hendricks when she was playing for the Angels.

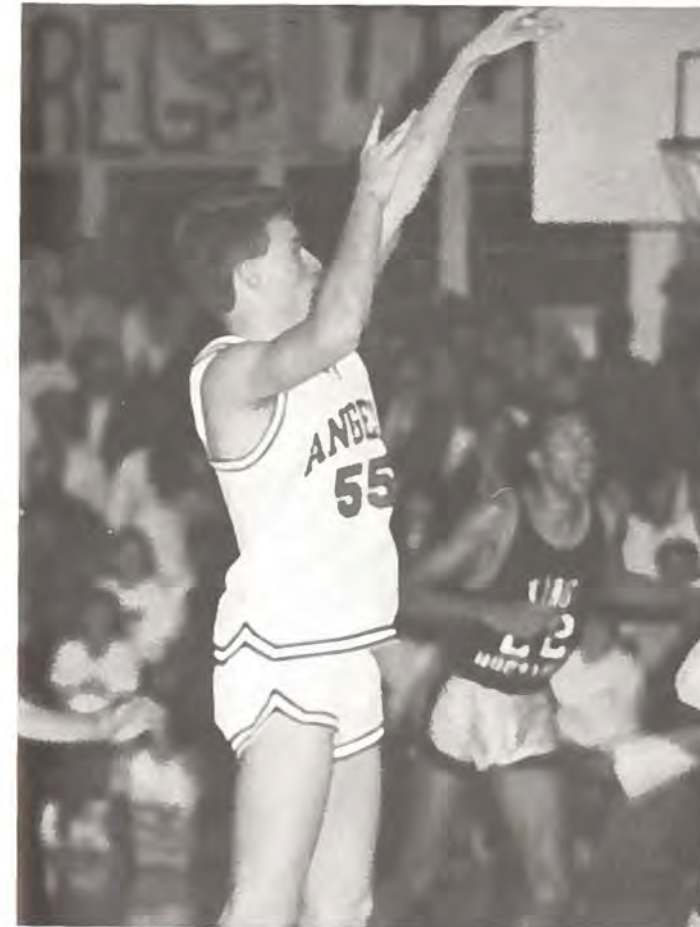

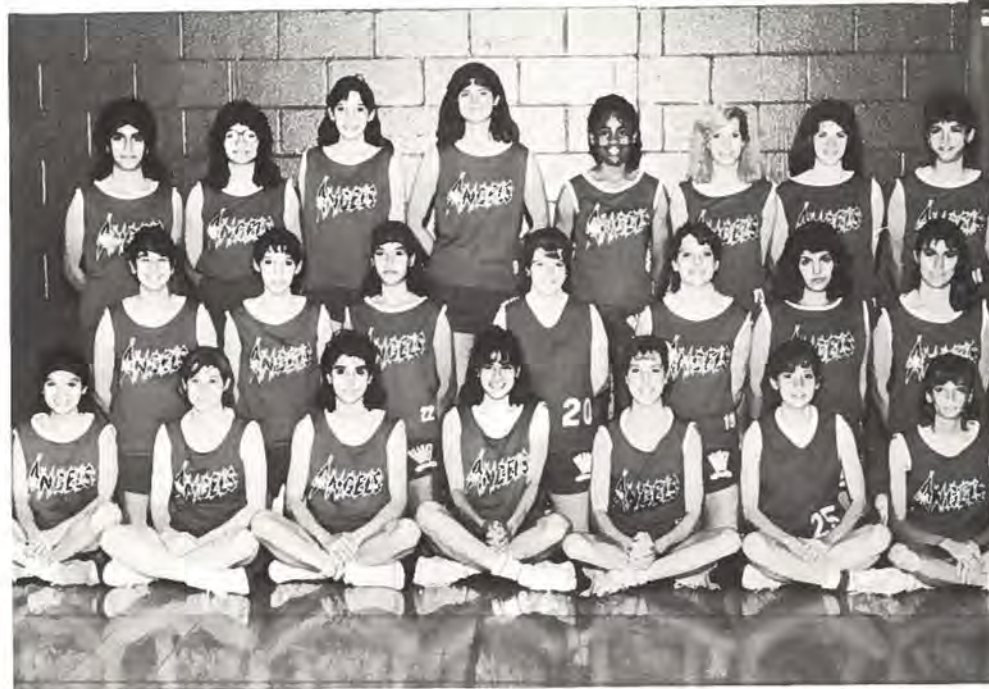

Record Breakers



Jason Williams broke his own school record for scoring and rebounding in a season. The 6'7" forward and post is expected to break this record again next year, his third year on varsity. 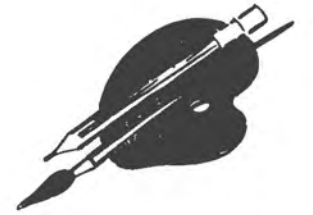

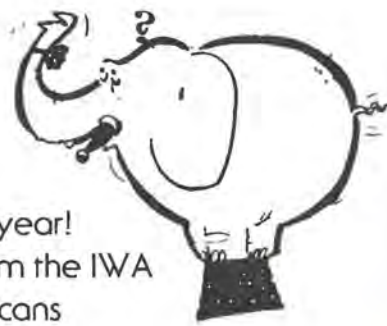
