- Allows for us to plan student supports

EH Data from August 1st until now...

Physical fighting

Classroom disruption in classroom that impacts/stops learning

Harassment

MINOR Incident Report: MIR- Considered Level 1 and 2

In the classroom this is teacher handled and can include various interventions.

- 1:1 Check -In with Student
- Contact home/Conference
- Cool down period
- Loss of Privileges

Issued MIR's can affect the ability to participate in school wide activities.



OFFICE Discipline Referral:

ODR- Considered Level 3 or 4

These are infractions reported to Administration for interventions which might include:

- Restorative Project
- Mediation
- Contact Home/Conference with parent/guardian
- Parent Shadow
- Loss Of Privileges
- Suspension



Issued ODR's <u>will</u> affect the ability to participate in school wide activities.

Level 4 Incidents are AUTOMATIC Suspension and Expulsion Hearing may have legal consequences

Investigations

All reported concerns are investigated

We want to get all the details and make a fair decision

Parents will be informed to collaborate and determine solutions

Our school should be a safe place for learning!

Mediation



- What is it? During mediation, students listen to each other present their side of a disagreement to find a common ground.
- What is the goal? The goal is to provide an environment for creative problem-solving.
- Who can benefit? Students, teachers and any staff
- When can it take place? At a time where it works for both parties
- Where does it take place? In Ms. Magaña's or Mrs. Montanaro's office
- Why have a mediation? It provides a neutral and confidential setting

Rules must be followed and your school is required to follow the law


Discrimination

Defined: Unfair treatment of one particular person or group of people.









Vaughn must follow the California Code of Regulations which are Laws that prohibits any discrimination on school grounds. These are not just School Rules it is the LAW!

Sexualism

Sexual **prejudice** (irrational opinion, thought or feeling) against sexual preference, identity, orientation or gender expression.

It's ok to have opinions about certain ideas but it is NOT ok to make anyone feel bad about their thoughts or opinions.

You do not have to agree with everything but you do have to respect differences.

Racism

The belief that one race is better than another.

This can include:

- Color
- Ethnic Identity
- Ancestry or National Origin

The use of the N-word whether with a hard R or soft R has no place in the educational campus.

Even if saying it to a friend that is not offended does not make it ok as anyone else that hears it can be offended.



Sexual Harassment

- Against the Law-Sexual Battery Report
- Includes: verbal comments, inappropriate notes to on about someone, text messages, social media comments, <u>physical touching</u> w/out consent
- Words/message can offend anyone who encounters it
- Parents of all parties involved will be notified, as well as law enforcement

**A report will be placed and Police will be involved

YONDR Pouches

- No phones out of pouch at school (includes afterschool program)
- Violations have consequences

Cyber Bullying

- Text Messages, burn pages, mean postings
- Social Media- Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Snapchat, etc.
- What to do if you receive derogatory messages?
- Sharing with many is the same as starting rumors yourself.
- Nude photos? Child pornography

Don't delete, screenshots, TELL an adult

Parents can ALWAYS go place a Police Report



Threats are not a joke...

THREAT: a statement of an intention to cause pain, injury, or damage on someone

Investigations take place to ensure safety. The process includes interviewing the person making threat as well as their parents

DO NOT MAKE THREATS TO PEERS or ADULTS!







