Dear families and staff of Parkway School:

To follow up our communications to you from Tuesday regarding the drinking water at Parkway School, we want to let you know that [the report](#), conducted by York Analytical Laboratories in conjunction with our consultants Foley's Pump Service, can be found on the web page dedicated to [Parkway School water updates](#).

The Connecticut Department of Public Health (DPH) has created [a very thorough informative webpage](#) for those that want to learn more about PFAS.

GPS tests the drinking water at Parkway regularly. The CT DPH established Action Levels for four PFAS (PFOA, PFOS, PFNA, PFHxS) in June 2022 and for another six PFAS (GenX, PFHxA, PFBS, PFBA, 6:2 CI-PFESA, 8:2 CI-PFESA) in June 2023.

The district's facilities team and our consultant are designing a filtration system and moving as quickly as possible to resolve the issue so that full water service can be restored to the building. We will continue to update the community as we have more to share.
