

STORYTELLING CLUB

This extracurricular activity designed for our youngest students, and its purpose is to foster imagination, art, vocabulary, friendship, self-confidence, and to have a fun time after the regular school day.

In bi-weekly storytelling classes, students will draw (PreK-K), or draw and write (Gr.1), and tell their own imaginary stories and adventures.

Imagination will be the strongest tool our students will use, and expressing themselves through storytelling, acting, drawing, and writing our students will strengthen many skills such as: self-confidence, creativity, self-expression, communication skills, concentration, cooperation, and listening skills.

The tutor will help them in their imaginative endeavors, and will read (and enact) picture books about chosen topics, which will include family, animals, environment, travelling, and more.

We will work on activities such as:

- Tell a story about what they see in a photo or picture.
- Explain what's in their drawings and artwork.
- Retell a story from a book with objects, or act it out. Draw their final draft.
- Make up their own story with drawings, objects, or figures collected in a tub.

The final result of the first trimester will be a book filled with the children's stories and pictures, which will be shared with parents during the last class before trimester two starts.
