We know starting in a new school can be a bit of "information overload" but we will have opportunities to build relationships and help you along the journey.

UPDATES AND REMINDERS

- There is an updated time frame of <u>5:00 to 6:30 p.m. for 7th and 8th Grade Supply Pick Up</u> <u>on August 31st</u>. If you are unable to pick them up supplies will be distributed to students on the first day of school.
- A letter was sent with detailed arrival and dismissal information. The only change is to dismissal procedures. <u>For safety, students taking the bus must exit through the front of</u> <u>the Middle School and use the Middle School path to the bus pick-up.</u>
- Students should check their <u>Lunch Period Room Number</u> so they know where to report at the beginning of their lunch period.
- <u>Cafeteria</u> indicates that students should go directly to the Cafeteria.
- <u>Recess</u> indicates that students should go directly to the recess area at the Main Entrance.

Chromebooks will be distributed to each grade as follows:


