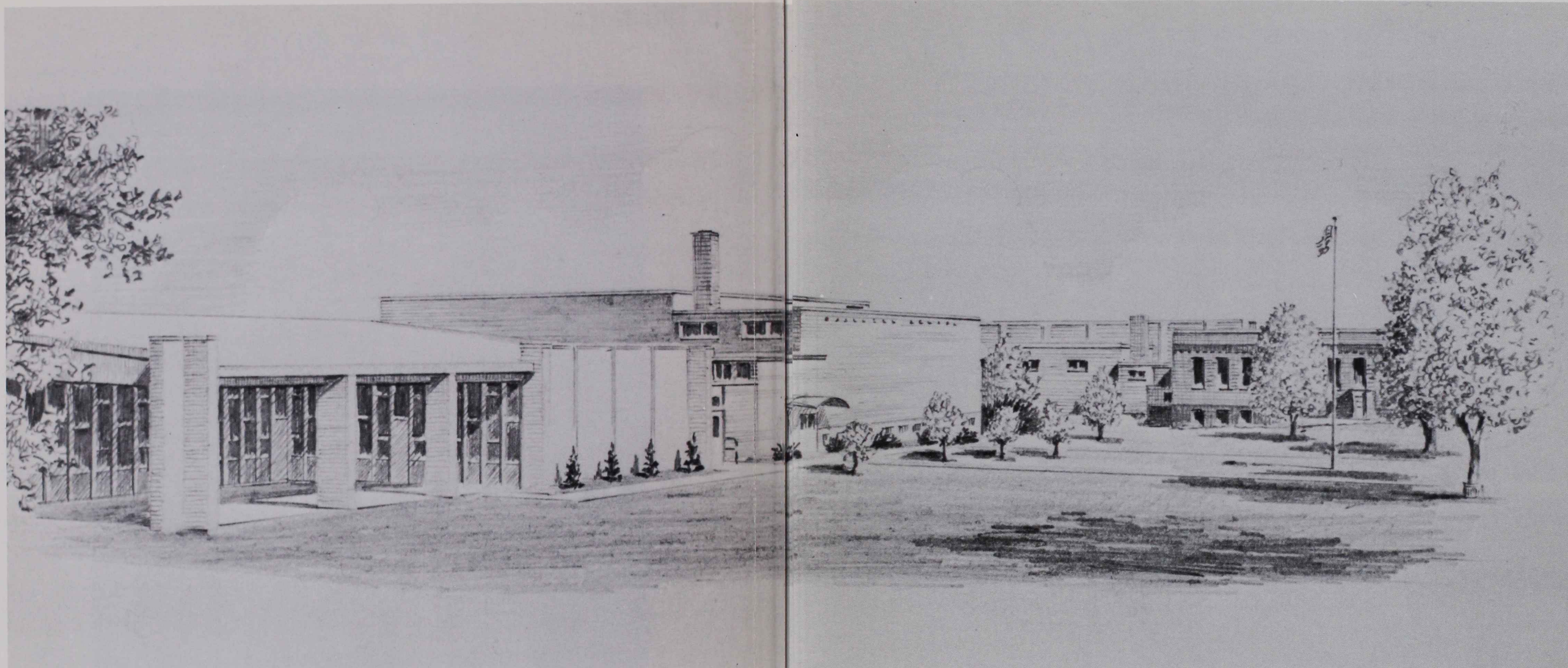
JOHN S. ROSA

The Student Council gave a percentage of the proceeds to the Adams County Society for crippled children and adults.



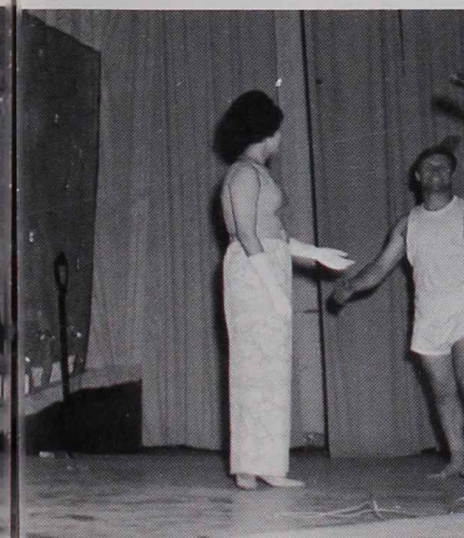

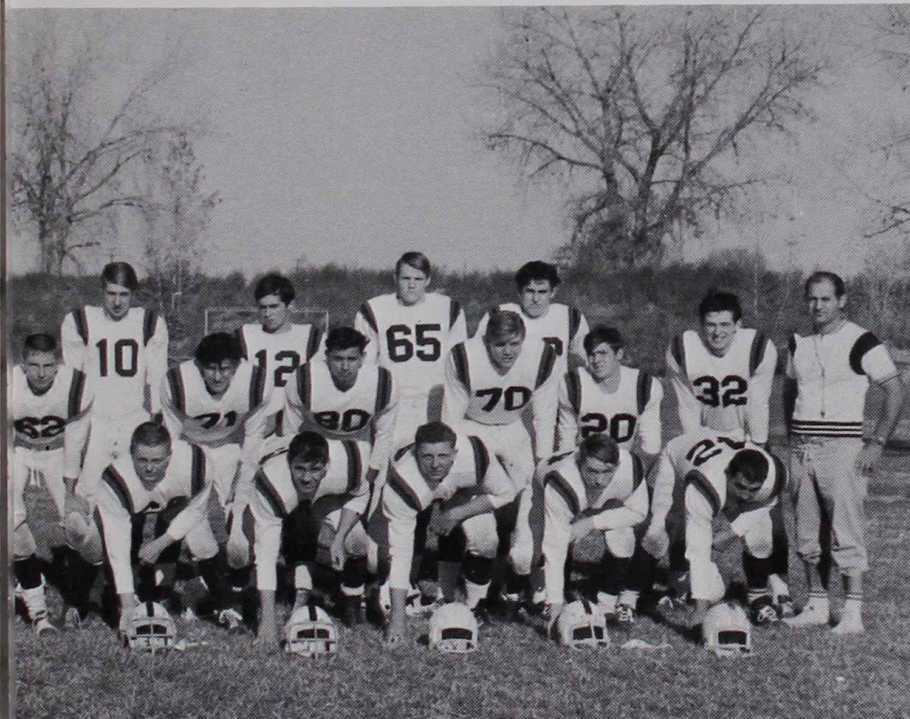
Although the team started out slowly they progressed steadily through the season. The results do not show a great winning record, but the team had a lot of drive and spirit.

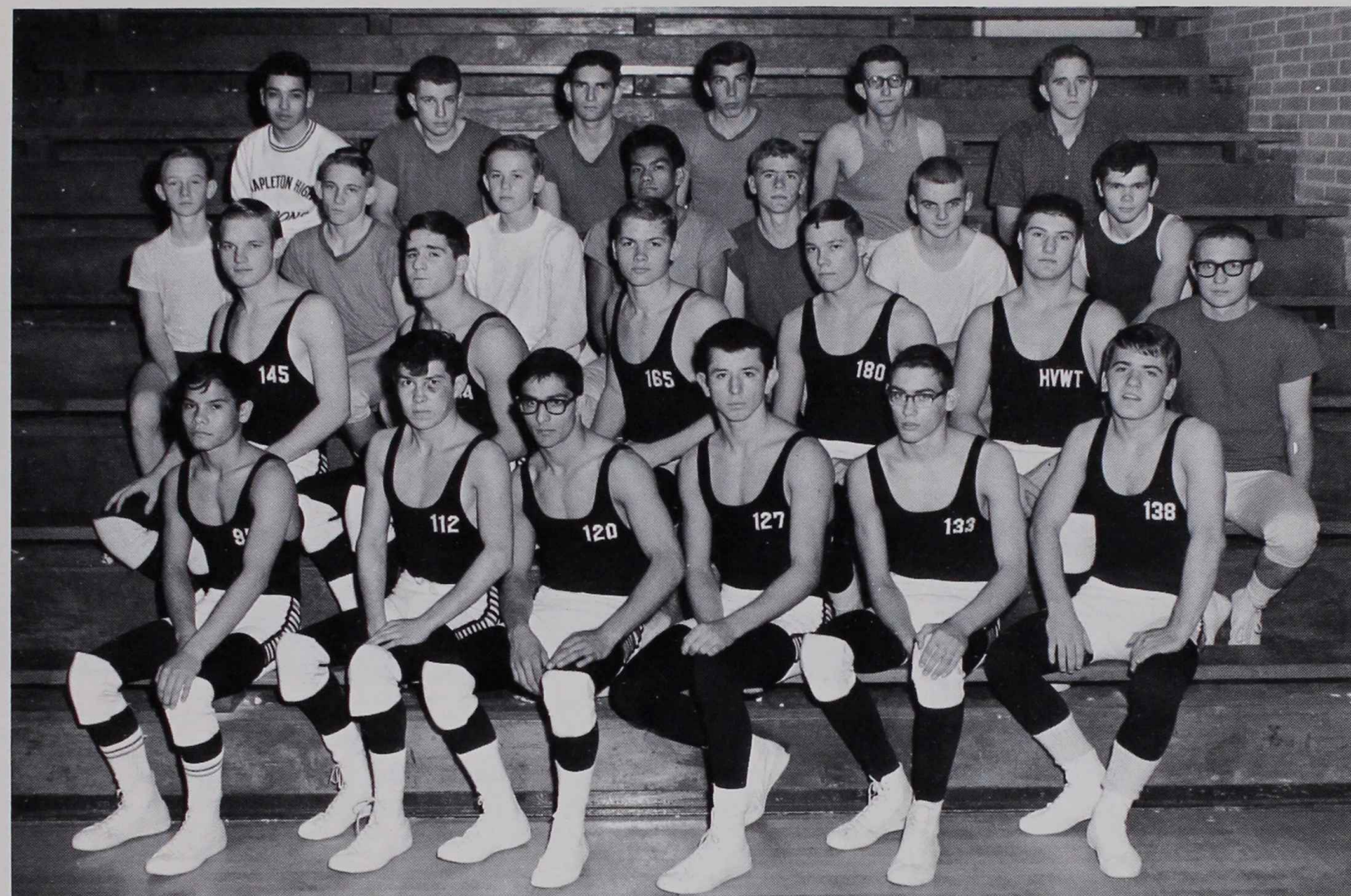
OUTSTANDING WRESTLER

Kim Hughes hit for the top batting average with .396. Kim was also selected on the All Conference Team.

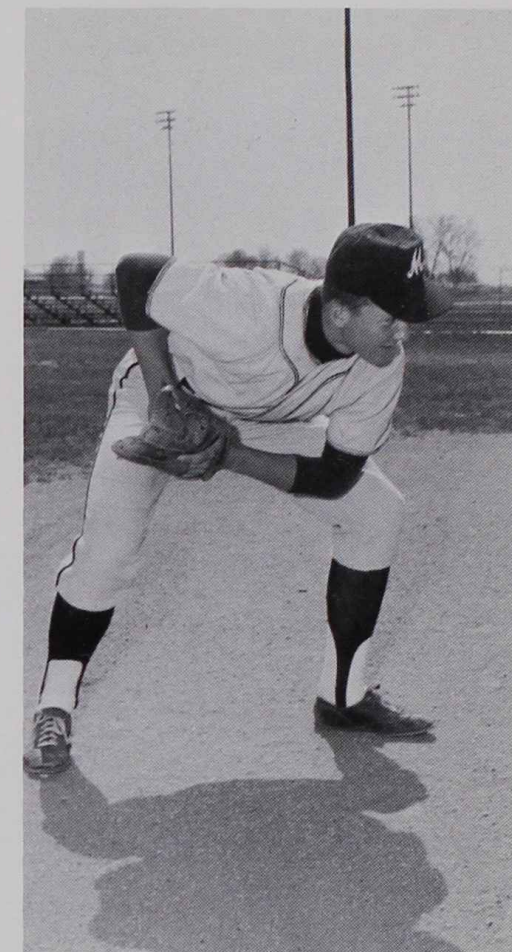
Bob Carabello was the R.B.I. leader and exhibited a tremendous amount of ability, hustle, and desire the latter part of the season.

The team was composed largely of inexperienced juniors, however many of these boys show a great deal of baseball ability.

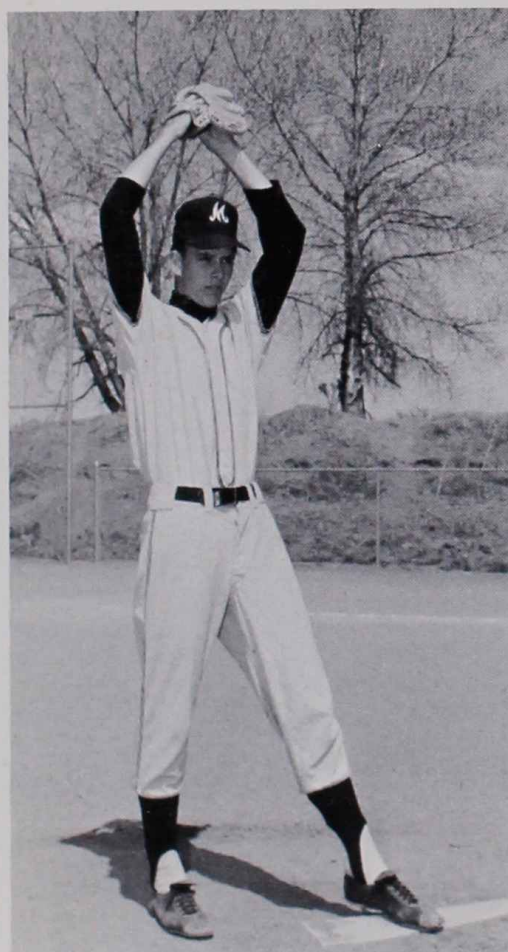
