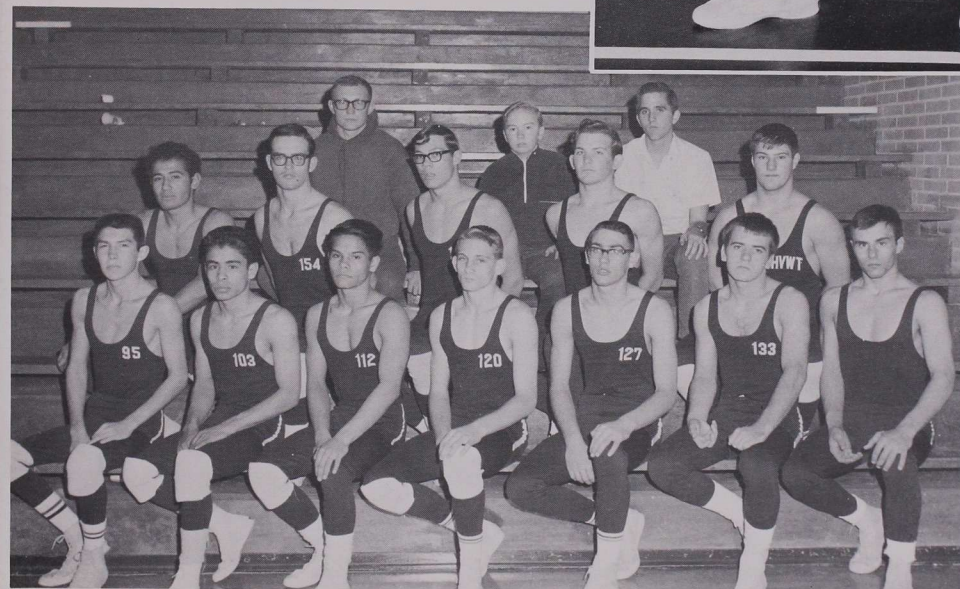
PAUL RAMIREZ
