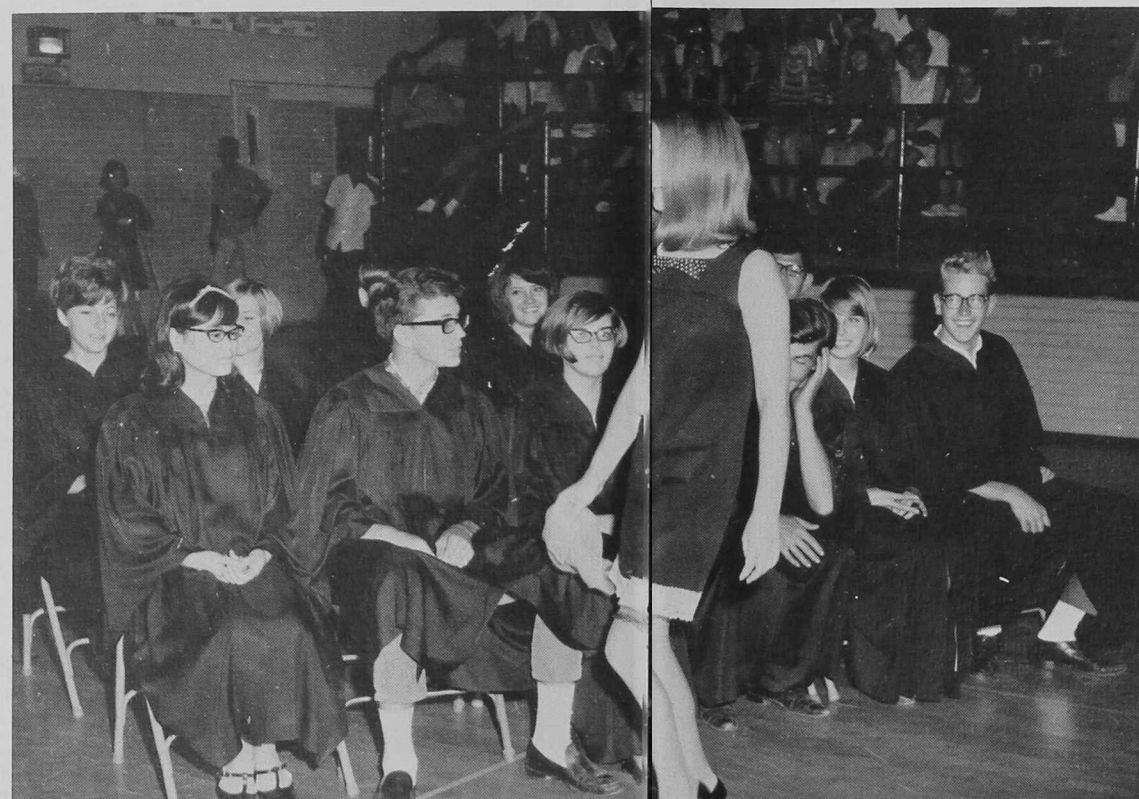
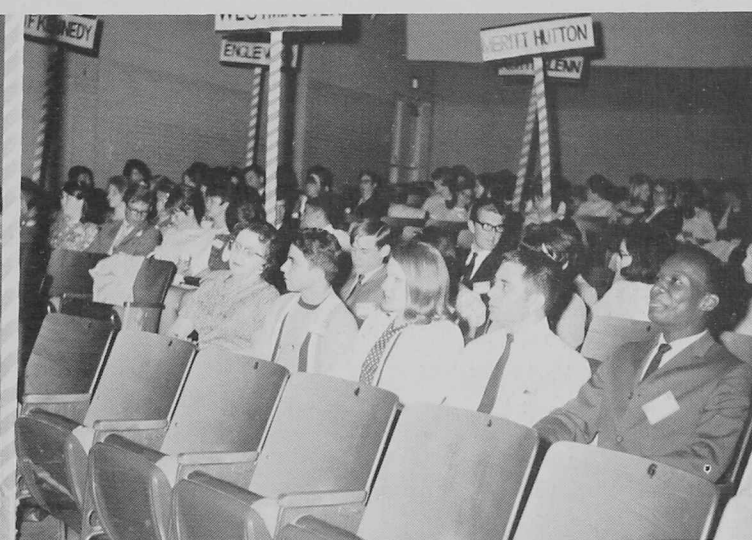
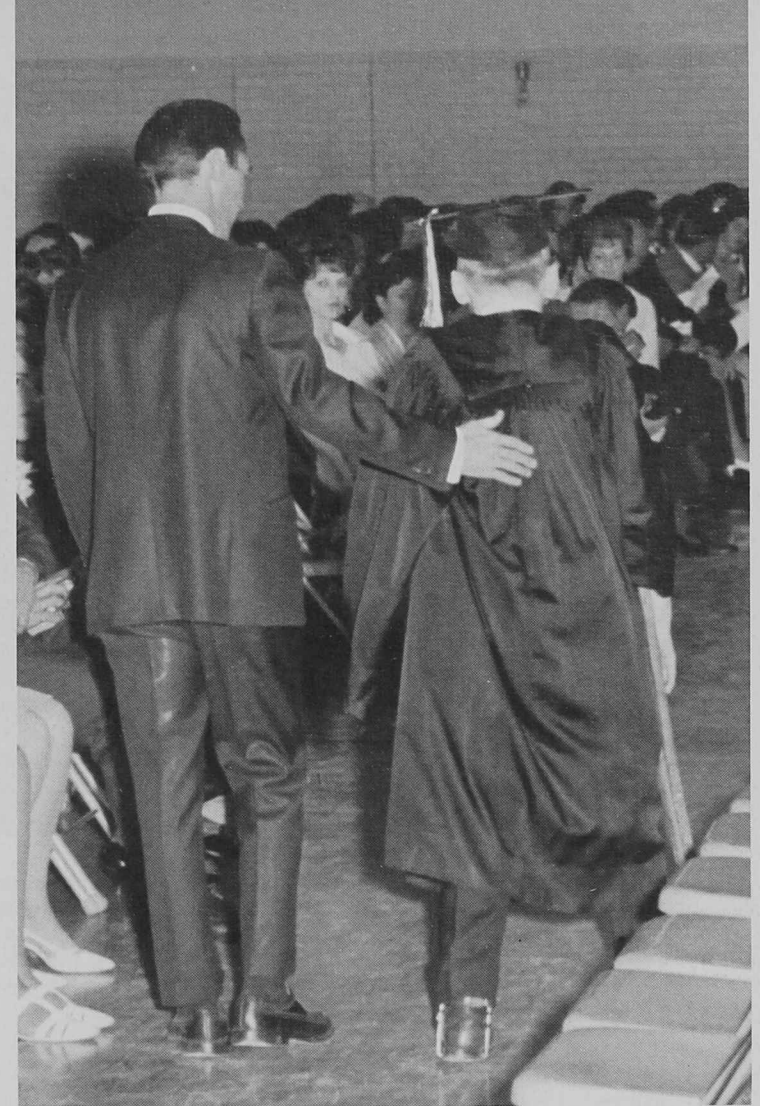
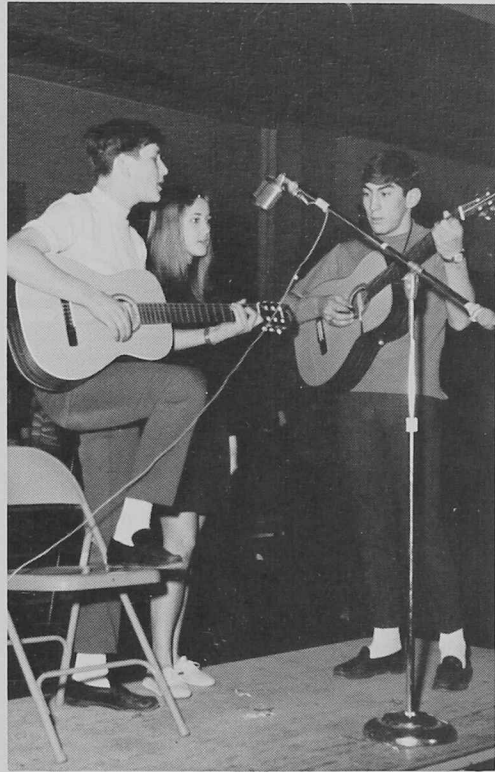
Foreword

Freedom Shrine

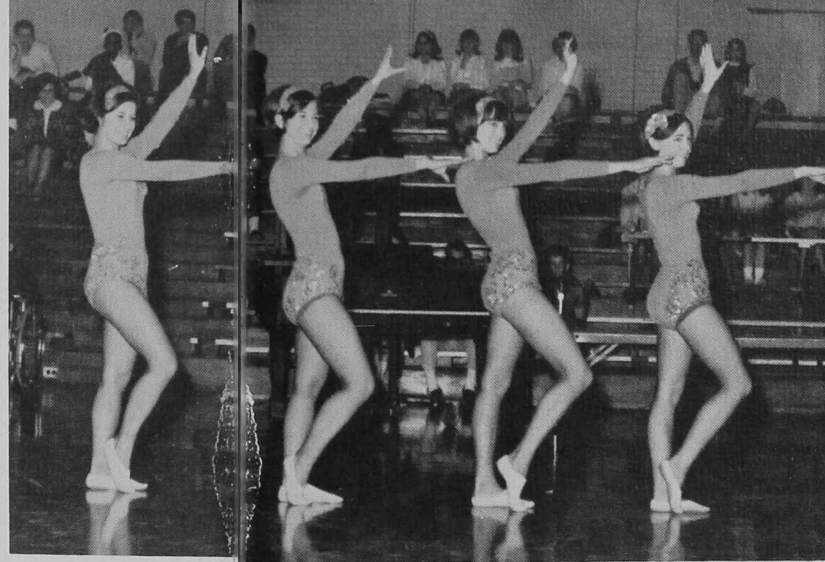

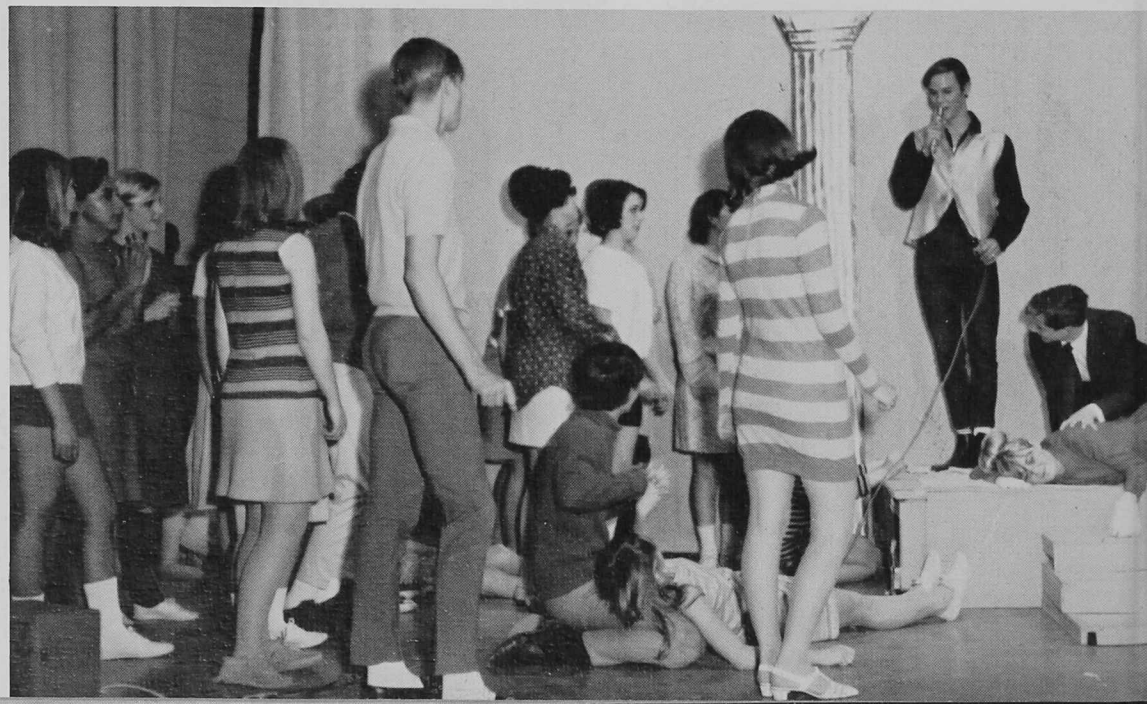

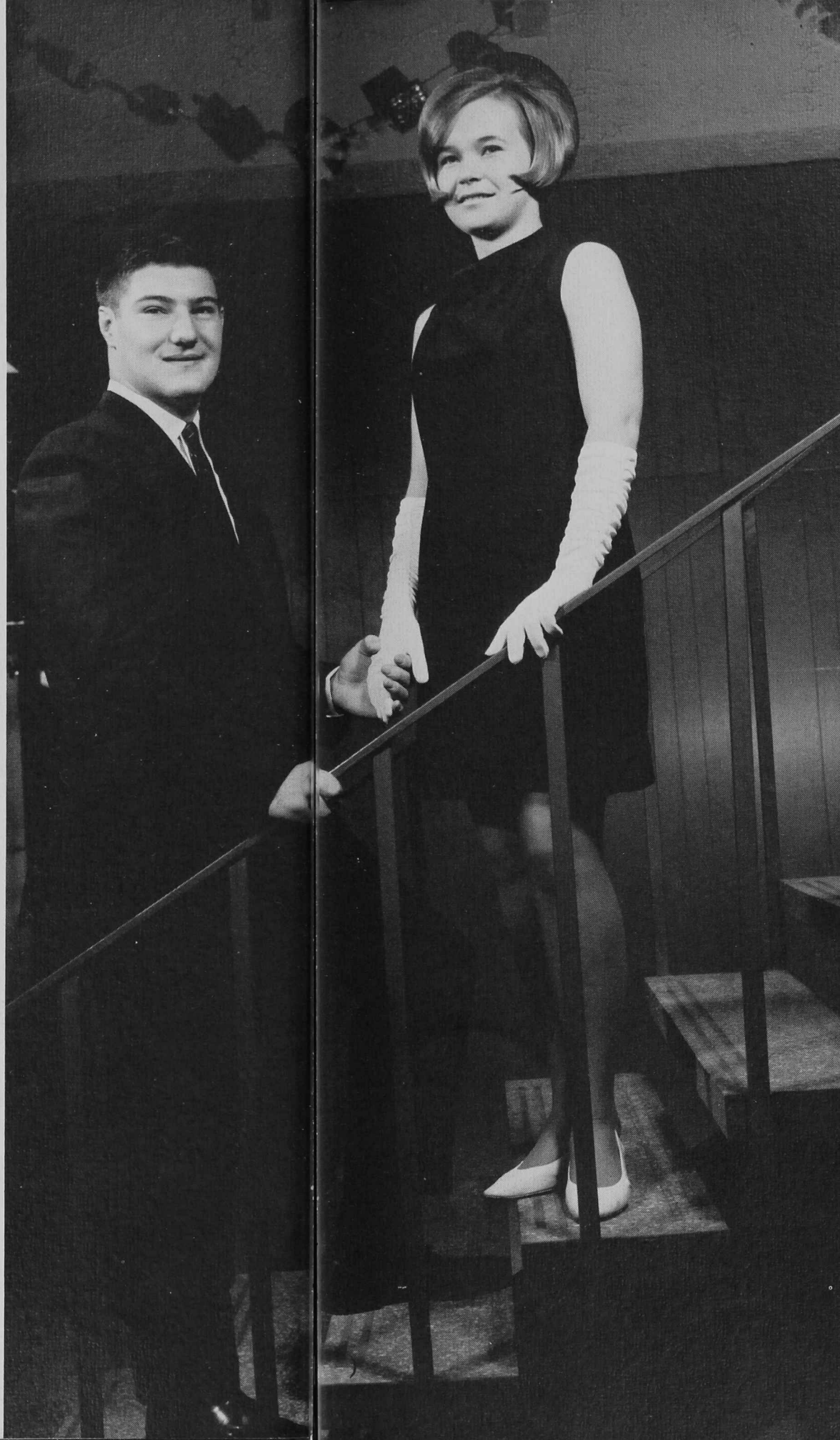
