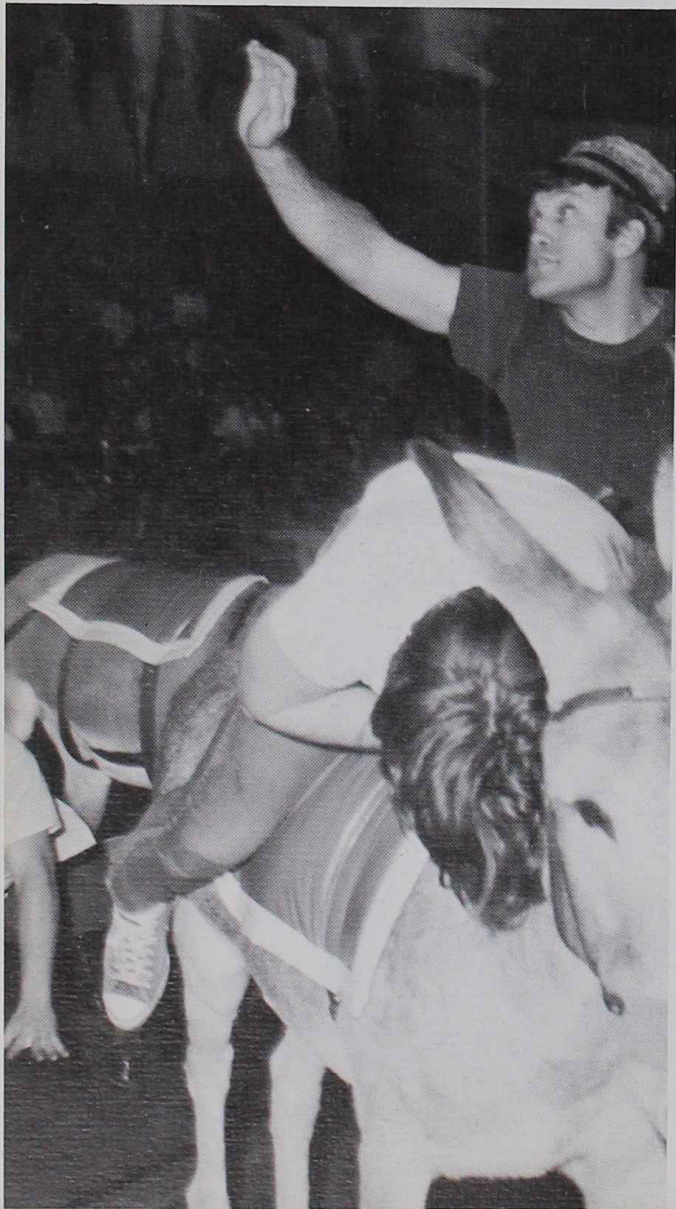
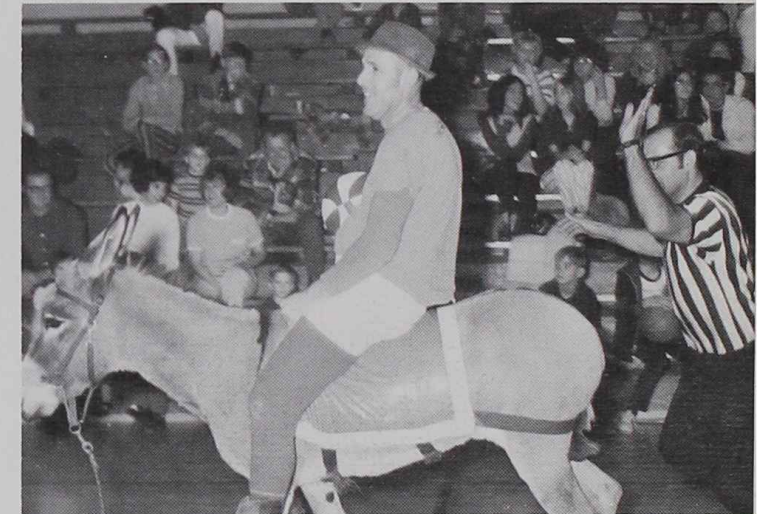
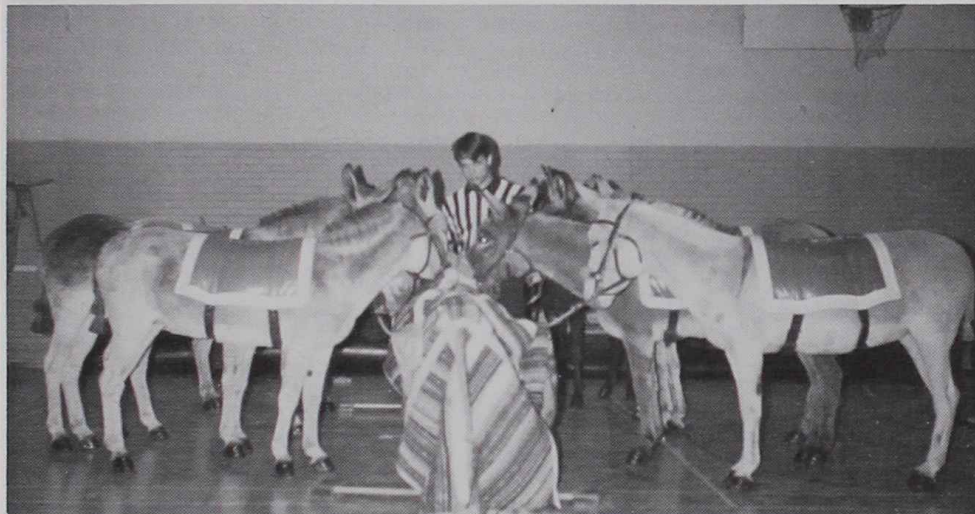
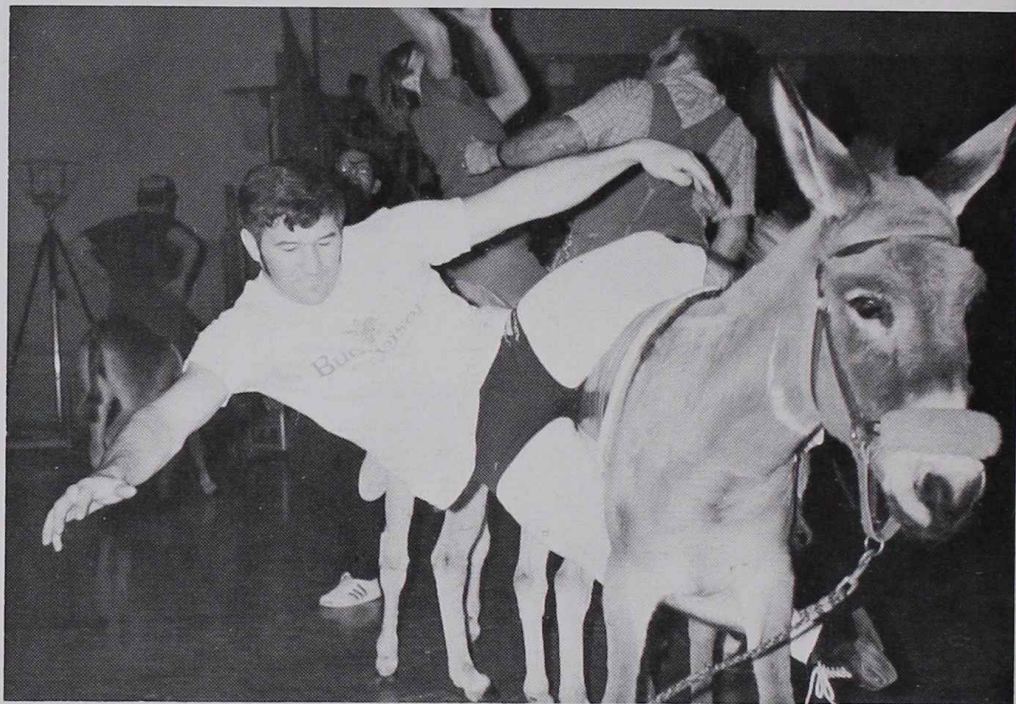
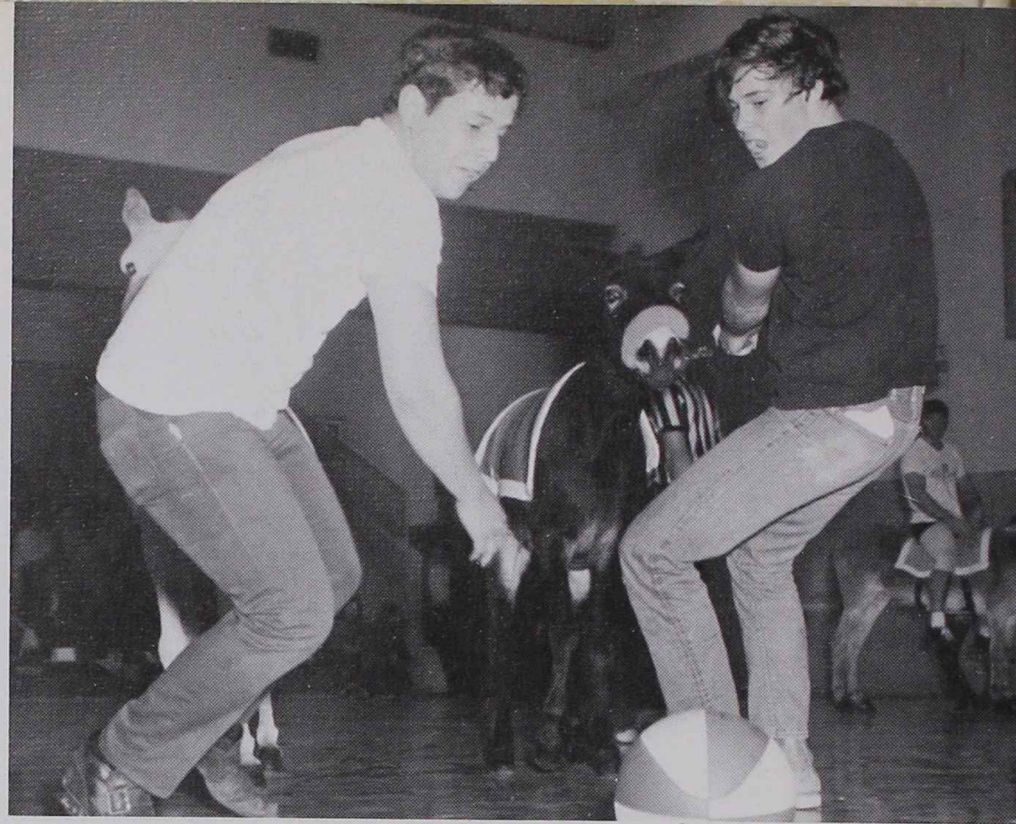


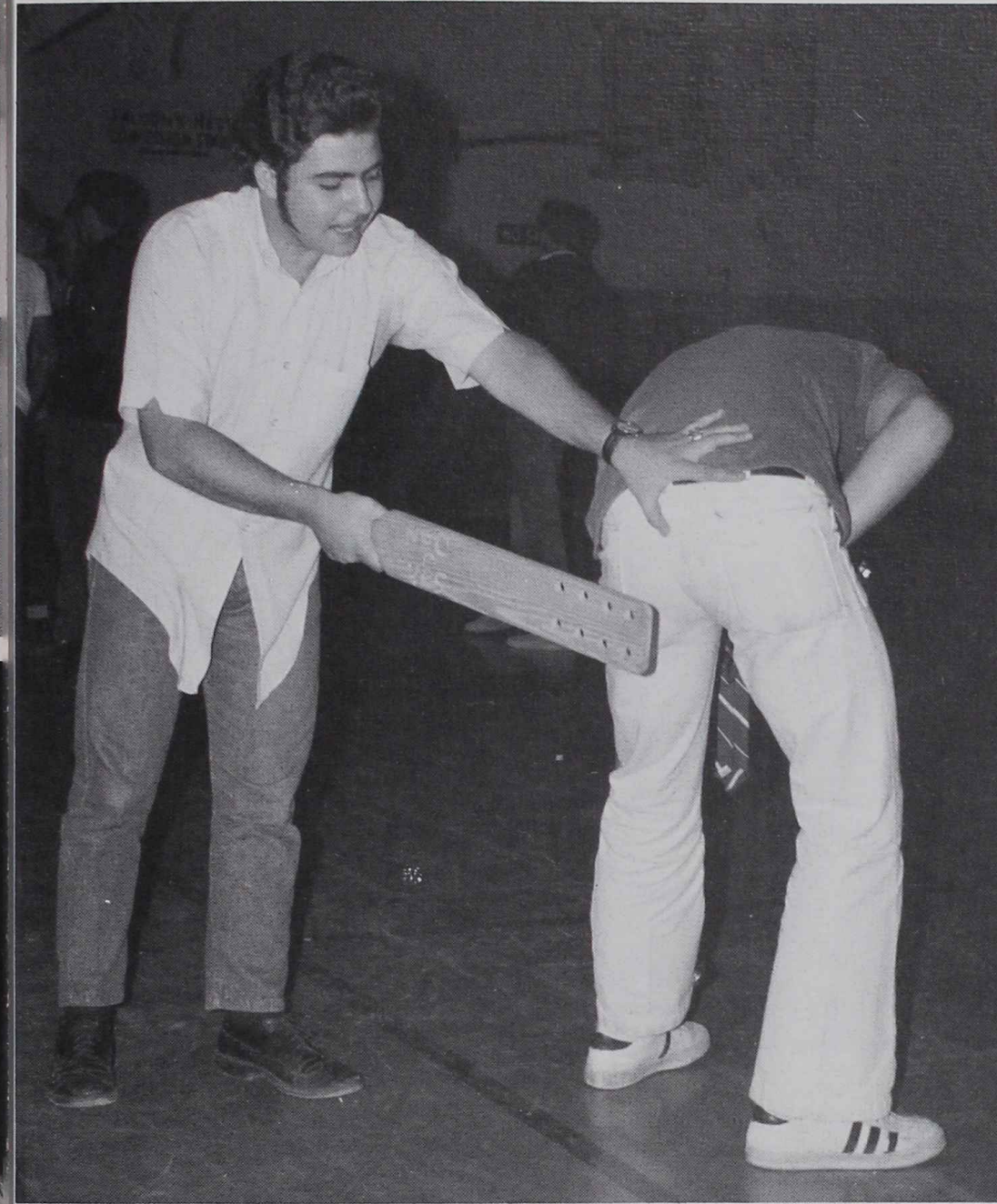
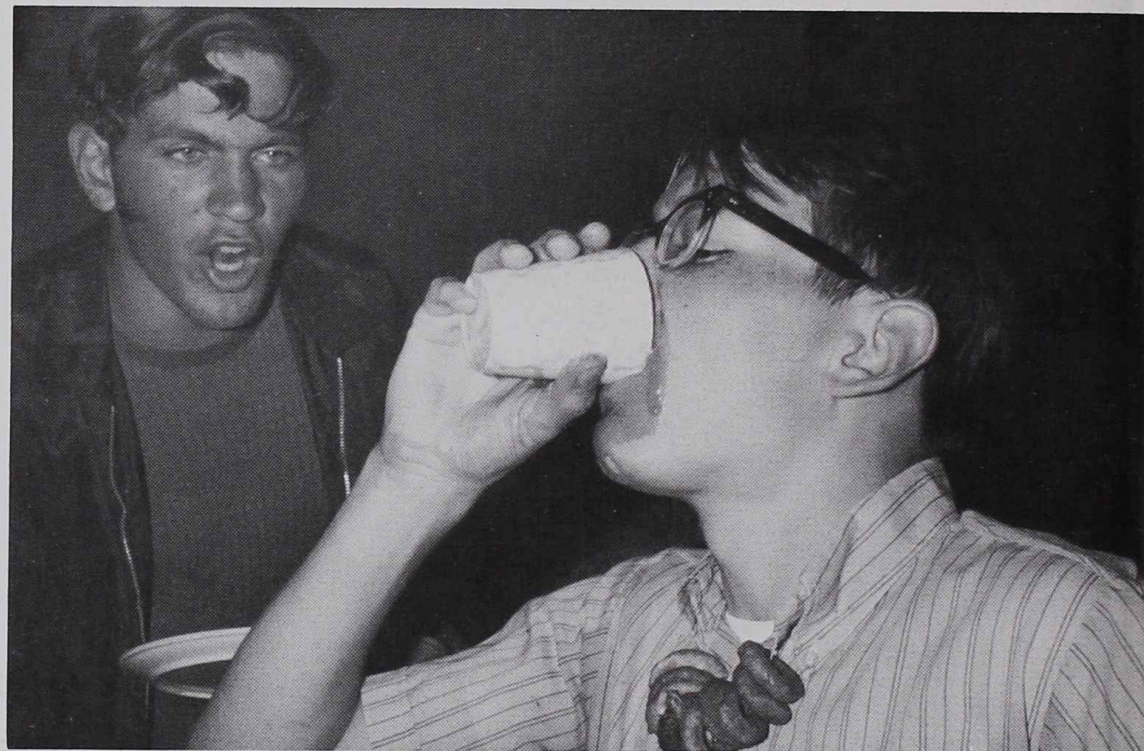
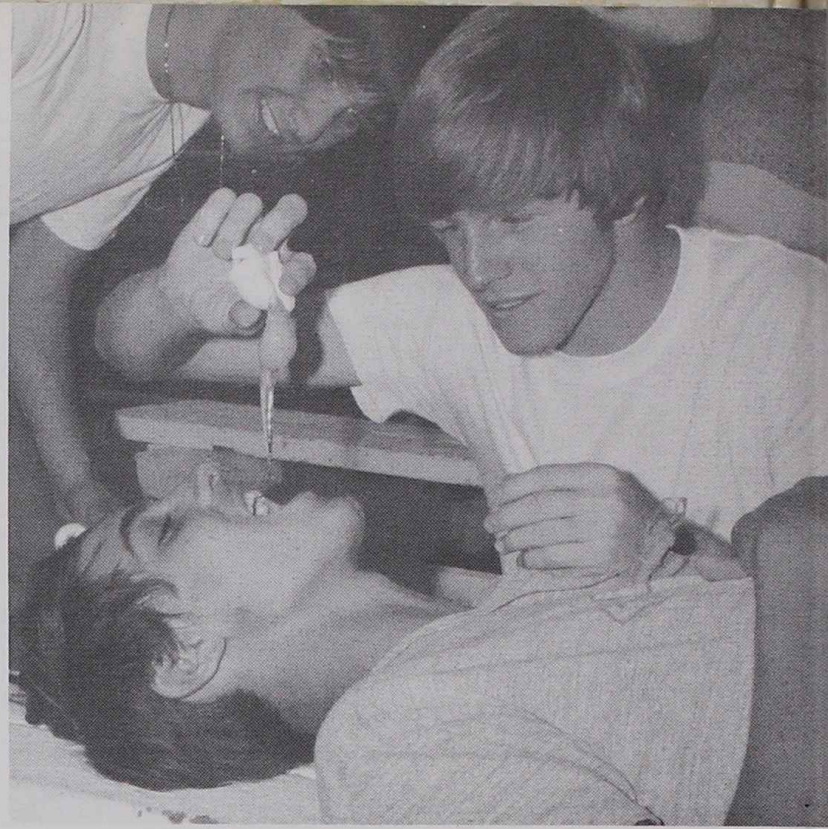
Exchange Students
