






Powderpuff

The Sophomore Class worked hard on their float this year and they came out with fourth place with their theme, "IF man loved each other like he loved his money, the world would make a profit".




In club float competition Child Care came up with first place this year with their theme "IF toys could talk".



Second place went to the Karate Club with this as their theme, "IF we could drop kick maybe we'd win some matches".







Welcoming Week






Kick-Off Dance

The Music Machine, a sound and light show, was the main attraction for the annual football kick-off dance. The dance was a big success and so was the football season.












Freshman
