The 1969-70 school year was a monumental one to say the least.

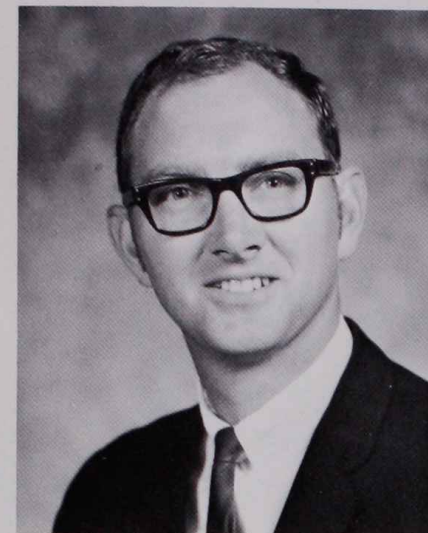

The challenge to make Highland a great educational center was accepted by both staff and student body. We've made some progress and are obligated to continue in order to accomplish more.

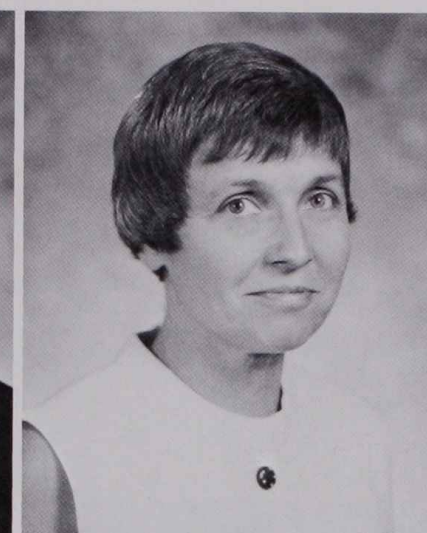

Once again thank you. It's a privilege to be a part of Highland.

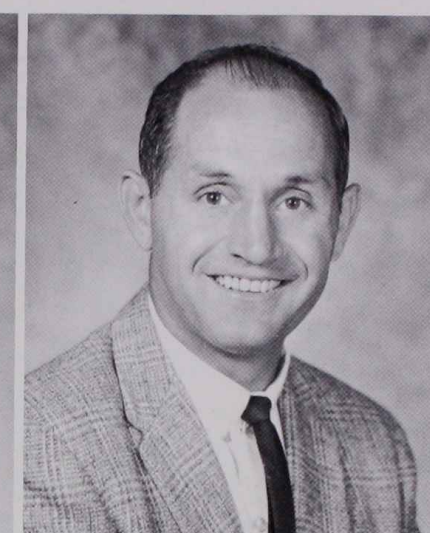
