This year, a grand total of 40 boys lettered, of which 27 will be returning next season. Four seniors received All Conference honors and two other players missed by

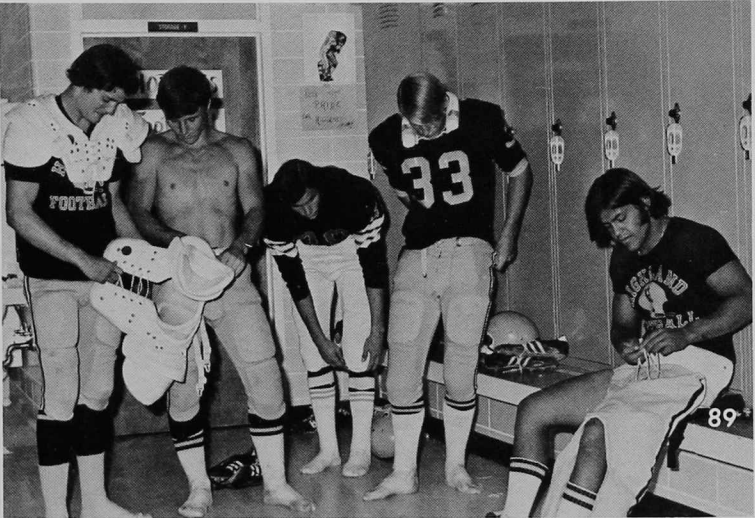

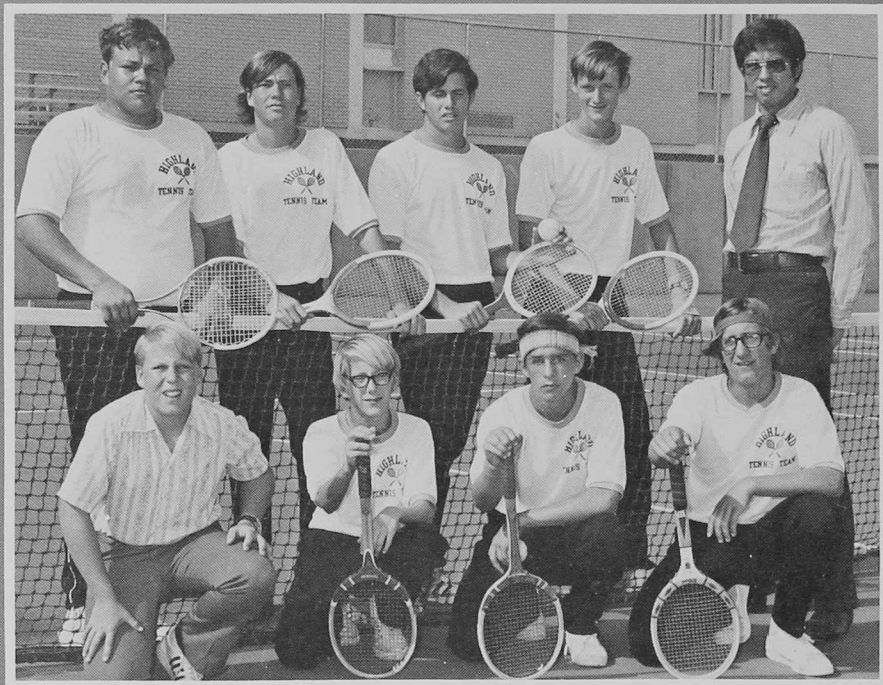


The Highland freshman team showed a lot of enthusiasm and determination this season. They finished their season on a winning note defeating Matchbuff and Mullen in their final two games.

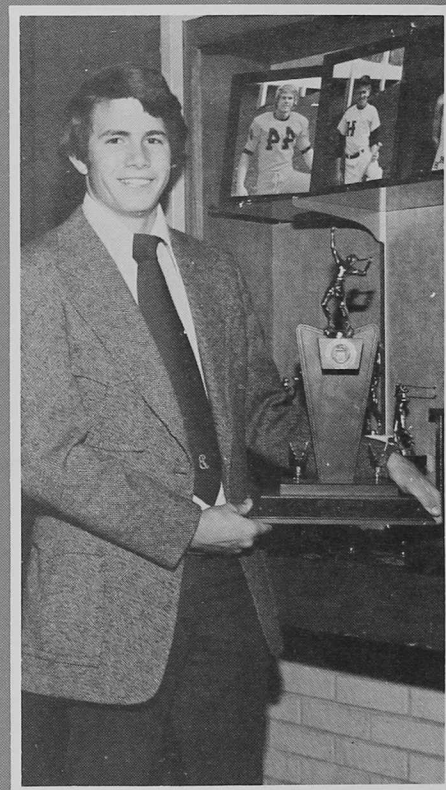

Their fine efforts in District took them to State competition, in which they finished 14th out-of 30 teams.

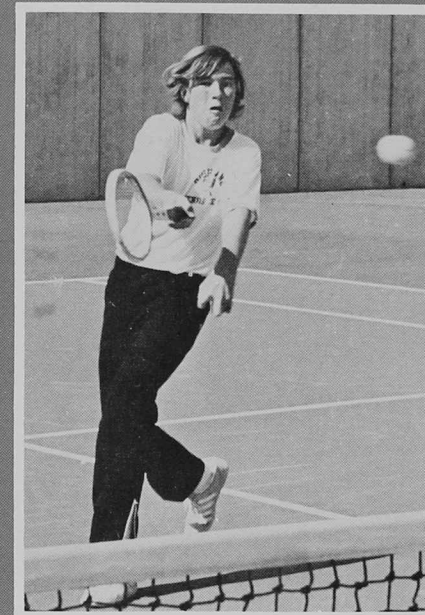
