

In May of 1973, one of the most exciting construction projects in Highland's history began. The construction company invaded our grounds and the long awaited swimming pool, auditorium, and vocational wing were soon to become an exciting reality.

With the advent of these additions we can boast of achieving a degree of comprehensiveness related to programs offered.

Our pool is designed for indoors, and will be 25 meters, and provides District One students and citizens an opportunity to be involved in a year round swimming program.

The auditorium will have chairs with padded backs and seats and will accommodate 743 people. It will be a tremendous asset for the performing arts department.

The vocational wing will house programs we have always wanted to add to our curriculum. They are auto mechanics, welding, metal, power mechanics, and provide a permanent home for the electronics programs.

Completion dates are a little ambiguous at this time. However, the construction company is talking January of seventy-four for the pool and vocational wing and February seventy-four for the auditorium.


















DEDICATION

German Club




YEARBOOK






The Highland High School athletic program is such that it takes into consideration almost all kinds of talent and personalities--everything from the total isolation of a Cross Country race to the pile of bodies on the line of scrimmage-and utilizes the full range of body types--thin, heavy, frail, muscular, tall, short, large, small. An individual may be competing as a part of a complete and highly coordinated unit or he may be competing individually. Some of our athletes must command a full range of skills, while others are valued for their speciality-kicking fieldgoals, pinch hitting, or high jumping. Some aspects of the athletic program at Highland High School require no contact at all, while others place the athlete in the heart of physical contact. Some challenges are very personal and others are totally impersonal.

This year Highland High School's Homecoming turned out to be a great success.


