

## Reflections of you and me




Once in awhile the school lunches get a bit monotonous,




#### Reflections of us


#### A new beginning

#### **Academics**

The 1976 Presidential Election was held November 2. Highland students had a mock election Friday, October 29, during lunches. Carter won.

Video tapes of the three debates were shown during the English classes on September 23, 24, October 7 and 29. These debates, which were shown on all three networks, were sponsored by the League of Women Voters. Mr. Nadon's U.S. Government students held mock debates to inform students on the issues during periods one and six on October 26, 27, 28.

Kennedy and Nixon had the first televised debate in 1960, but Ford and Carter were the first to hold three separate debates: on Sept. 21 they debated domestic issues; on Oct. 6 they debated foreign policy; and on Oct. 22 they debated all issues. The first Vice Presidential debate in the United States history was held on Oct. 15 between Dole and Mondale.








#### Love-tennis



The football team, under head coach Mr. Gerry Houck, finished first place in the National Division of the Skyline League.




Hot pretzels and balloons started off this year's Oktoberfest held by the German Club, Friday, October 29.


The dinner menu included beef roladen, boiled potatoes, three bean salad and apple strudel. During the dinner a polka band, consisting of Highland students, performed.

The Oktoberfest is a traditional celebration of the marriage of the Prince of Rumania and Princess of Australia, celebrated by the citizens of Munich.












The Varsity team finished with a 9-7 record which was good enough for second in the skyline standings.

The team next year will have six returning players.








The Varsity team, scoring an 86.1 for their highest total of the season, placed 5th in the Skyline League.


Senior Susan Soulia placed 8th on the uneven parallel bars in the District finals. She was the only member to qualify. The team placed ninth out of twelve schools.






#### Girls' swimming

According to Coach Cheryl Tufly, "They were the most improved." All of last year's records were broken this year.


Mary Ann Zeylmaker, a freshman diver, was the first Highland swimmer to qualify for a State meet. She placed tenth overall.

## Will ski weather ever come?





Marianne Cato and Marlayne Vandenburg finished the season in the top ten scoring bracket. Both of them were named to the National Division All Conference first team.



The power of the team was made up of four seniors and nineteen returning under-classmen for a strong back-up.











Steve Johnson was the valedictorian and delivered the valedictory address. Terry Melonakis, salutatorian, delivered the invocation.


The presentation of the class gift, which is a 3-D map of the school, was given by Dennis Uthe, class president.
