Congratulations to everyone involved with the musical.



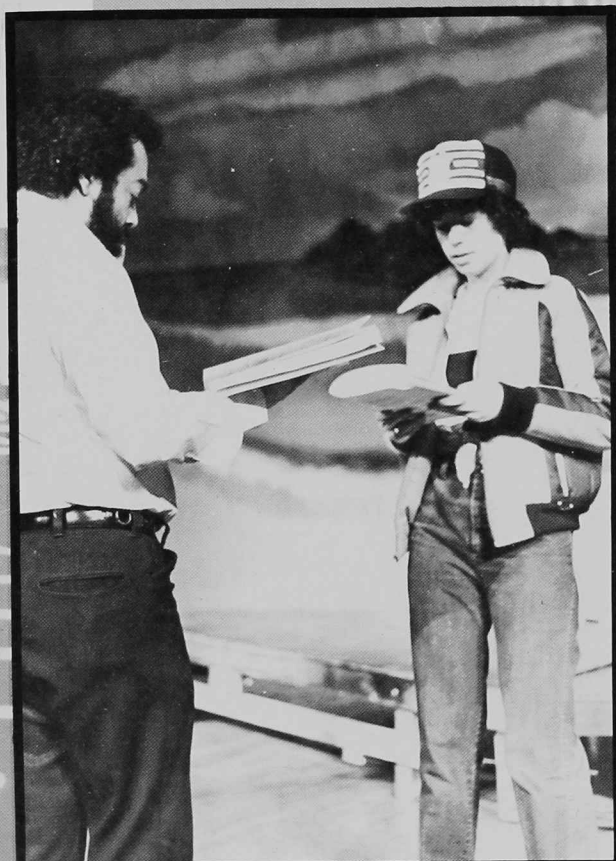
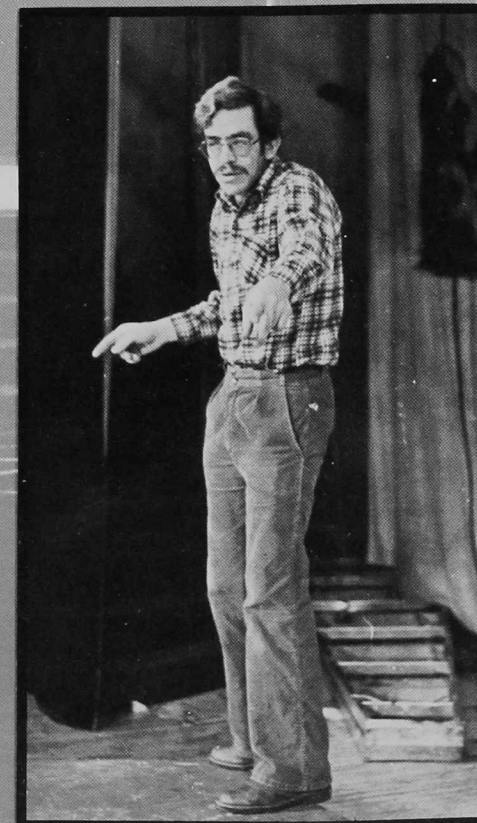

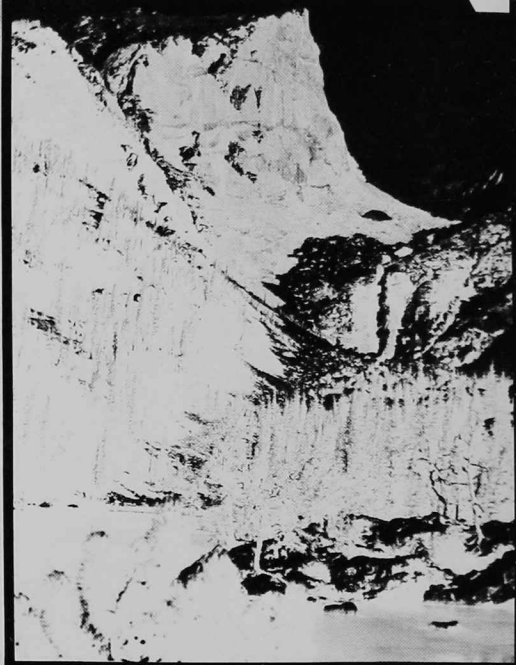

Let me know the way.

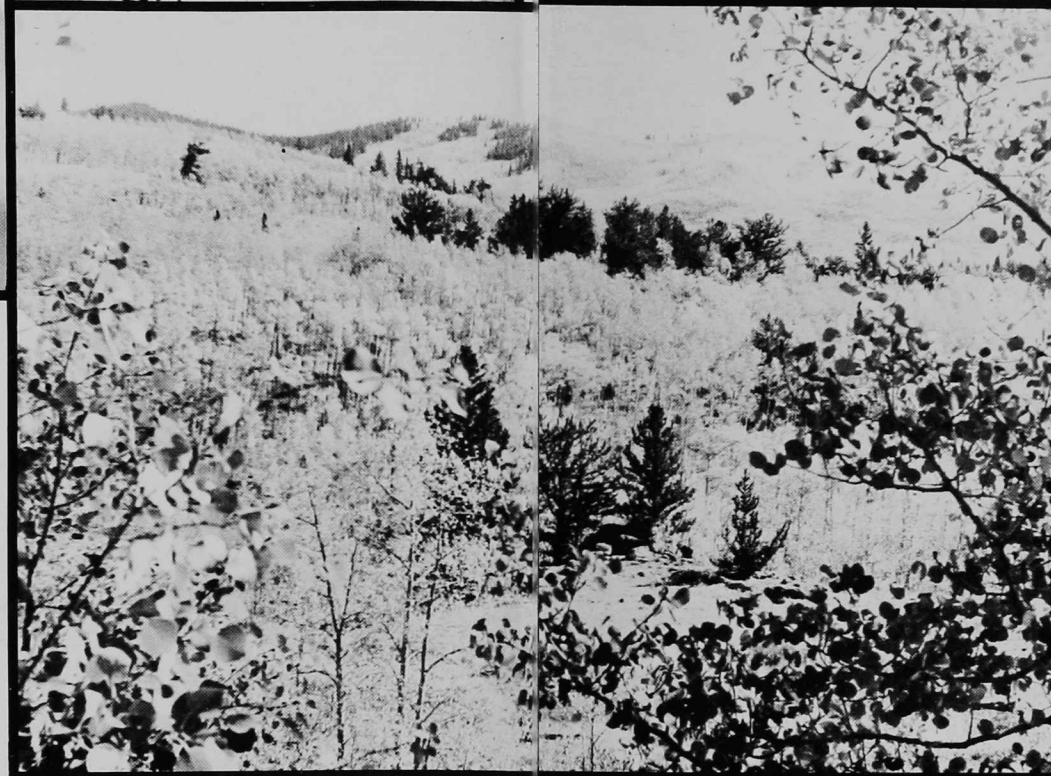


# DON'T LOOK BACK

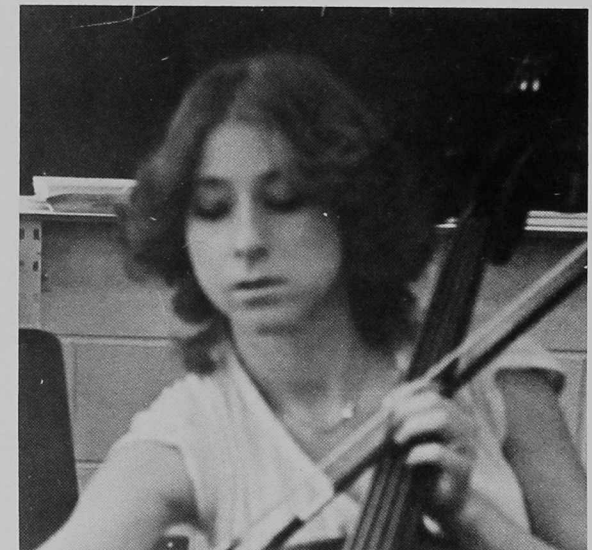
# ORCHESTRA

The 1979-80 Service Project is a Tutoring Program in which members help other HHS students in an academic area.

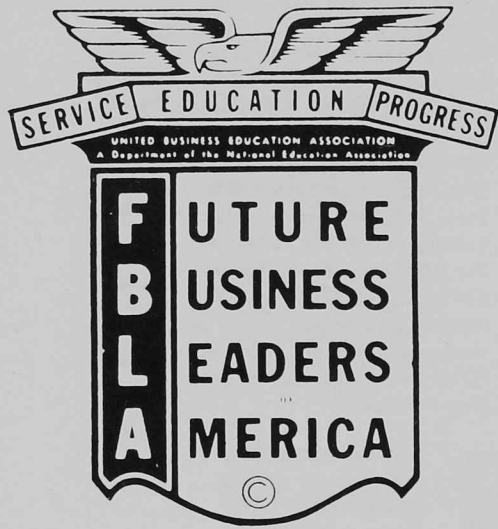
The Induction Ceremony will be held in the Spring for next years Juniors and Seniors.

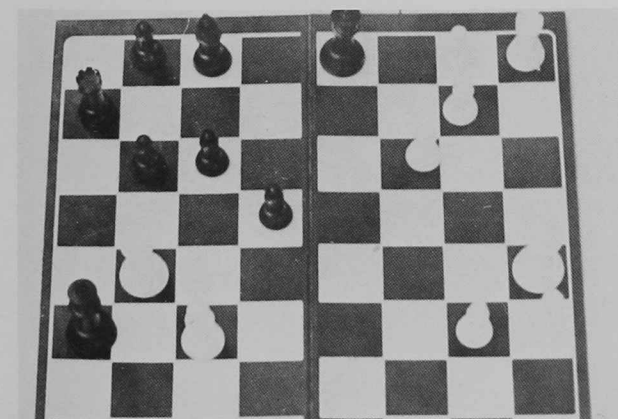

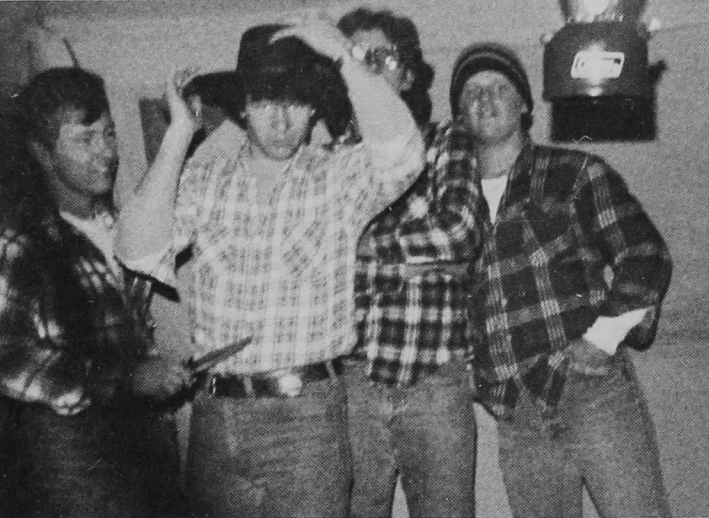

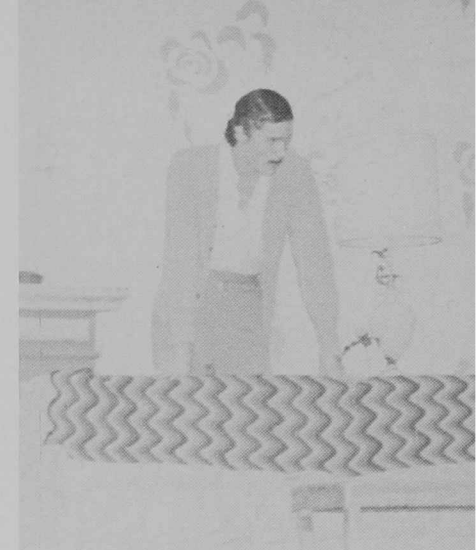

 "My job with student council is as an advisor. I help them with their ideas on different school projects, and help in the direction they should take to make a success of their projects.

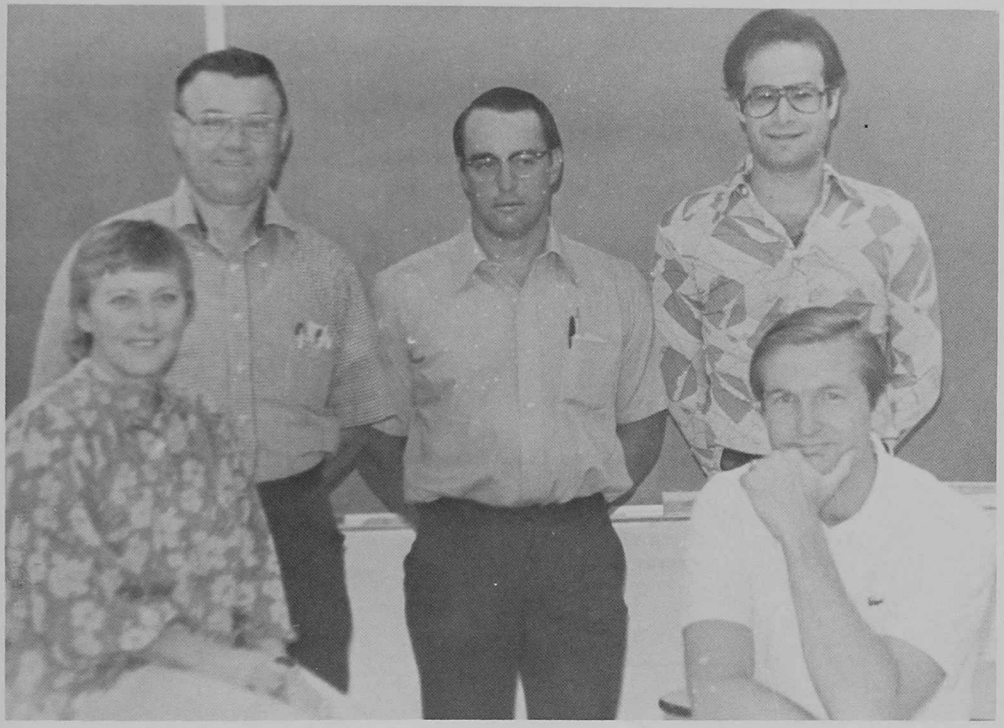

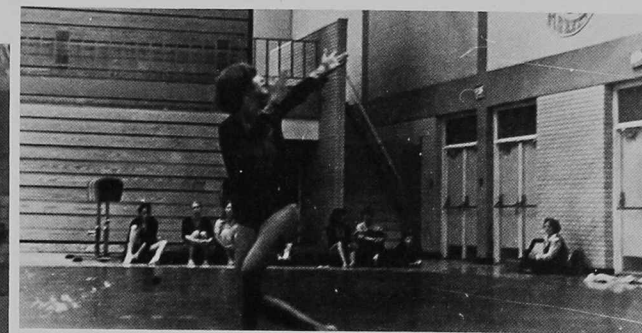
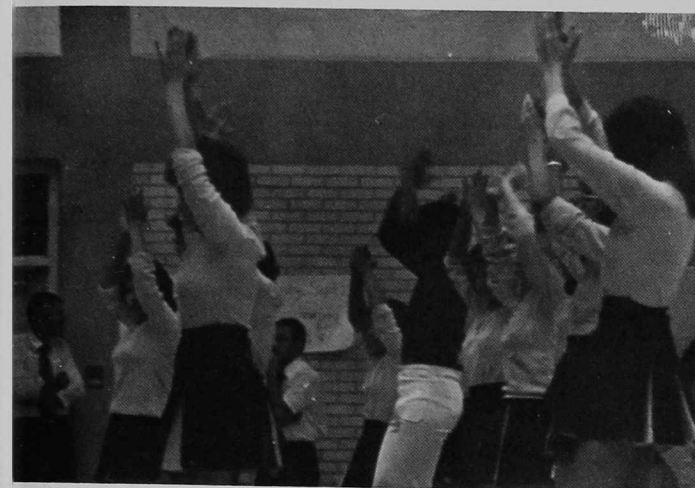


# Drill Team

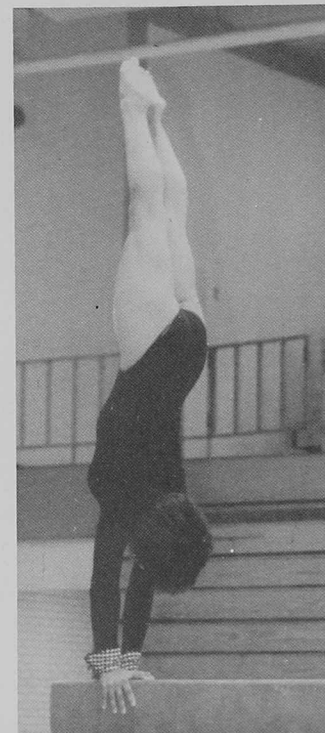
# GYMNASTICS "1"

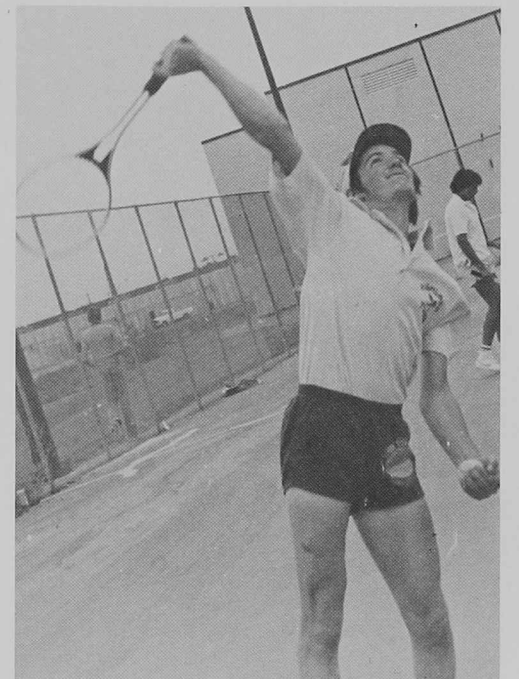
## TENNIS
