Board places \$9 million mill levy override on November ballot

In response to the recommendations and requests from our families and community members, Mapleton's Board of Education is asking voters to support a \$9 million mill levy override on the November 2022 ballot. The board voted unanimously in favor of the measure during a regularly scheduled business meeting on Tuesday, Aug. 23. If passed, it will support safety and security improvements, enhanced career and technical opportunities for students, and building maintenance and replacements. Read more <u>on our website</u>.

More than a Meal and Nutrition Services updates

There is still time to submit your family's meal benefit application! Unlike the last two years, the USDA is requiring families to complete a <u>Meal Benefits</u> Application to determine free and

reduced meal eligibility. And as you



know, each application is worth so much more than a meal.

Families can also receive perks like school-related fee waivers and discounted utility

services, while their child's school can secure funds for classroom resources or before and after school enrichment activities.

Mapleton Public Schools was selected by the Colorado Department of Education (CDE) as a recipient of the Local Food Program Grant, a program that strengthens farm-to-school connections and supports Colorado food producers. Mapleton received \$30,000 to use toward the purchase of locally grown fruits and vegetables, including watermelons, peaches, romaine lettuce, tomatoes, carrots, and cucumbers.

The Local Food Program is a pilot program in its second year that aims to provide Colorado children access to nutritious, high-quality, local food so they can excel in the classroom.
