The "Final Four" is a conversation focused on



the repair and/or replacement of the remaining four buildings that have served us well over the years but have received modest upgrades and improvements. These buildings include:



- Achieve Academy (K-8)
- Meadow Community School (K-8)
- Preschool on Poze (Preschool)
- York International School (K-12)

When we started on our Facilities Master Plan in 2006, nearly every facility was more than 50 years old, had significant infrastructure problems, and had exceeded useful life.

With the 2010 and 2016 bond programs, along with multiple grants through the Building Excellent Schools Today program, we have been very fortunate to have the opportunity to renovate or rebuild almost every school building in the district!


We are now looking at Mapleton's "Final Four" facilities. 
Upcoming Final Four site-based meetings:

Community survey results

In late 2021, Mapleton Public Schools retained Corona Insights to conduct a survey of employees, students, and parents/guardians. The goal of this research was to examine the opinions and perceptions of the school district within our community by measuring satisfaction and identifying areas for potential improvement.

The surveys were designed to collect the following information:

- How do Mapleton Public Schools employees rate the district's performance in a variety of areas related to employment and provision of services to the community, and what can Mapleton do to improve employee happiness and success?
- What is the student experience at Mapleton Public Schools, and what are priorities for improvement?
- How do parents and guardians rate the district's performance relative to their child(ren)'s education?

I Matter, funded by the Colorado Department of Human Services, Office of Behavioral Health, provides up to three free behavioral health sessions for youth in Colorado.



Colorado House Bill 21-1258 established this temporary behavioral health services program to provide access to mental health and substance use disorder services for youth, including addressing needs that may have resulted from the COVID-19 pandemic. The program is open to youth 18 years of age or younger or 21 years of age or younger if receiving special education services.
