Test to Stay Program from the CDPHE

Mapleton Public Schools is now enrolled in the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment's Test to Stay Program. This program is another tool to help keep our students in school learning safely.

Test to Stay is available to both students and staff and allows individuals with certain exposures

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some individuals. In Mapleton, this would include some household exposures and outbreak exposures. Schools will provide testing materials (two Abbott BinaxNOW OTC



tests) to individuals enrolled in the Test to Stay program.

I Matter - free behavioral health sessions for youth

I Matter, funded by the Colorado Department of Human Services, Office of Behavioral Health, provides up to three free behavioral health sessions for youth in Colorado.



Colorado House Bill 21-1258 established this temporary behavioral health services program to provide access to mental health and substance use disorder services for youth, including addressing needs that may have resulted from the COVID-19 pandemic. The program is open to youth 18 years of age or younger or 21 years of age or younger if receiving special education services.
